

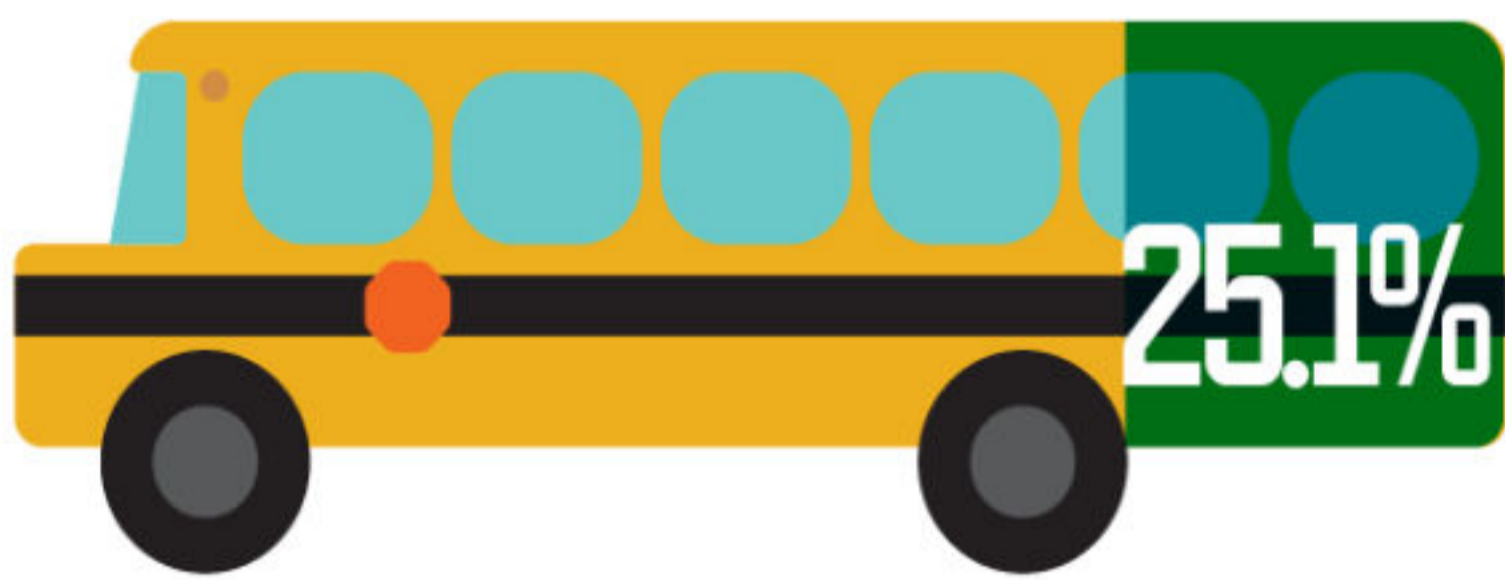

About 25.1% of Florida third graders have untreated tooth decay.

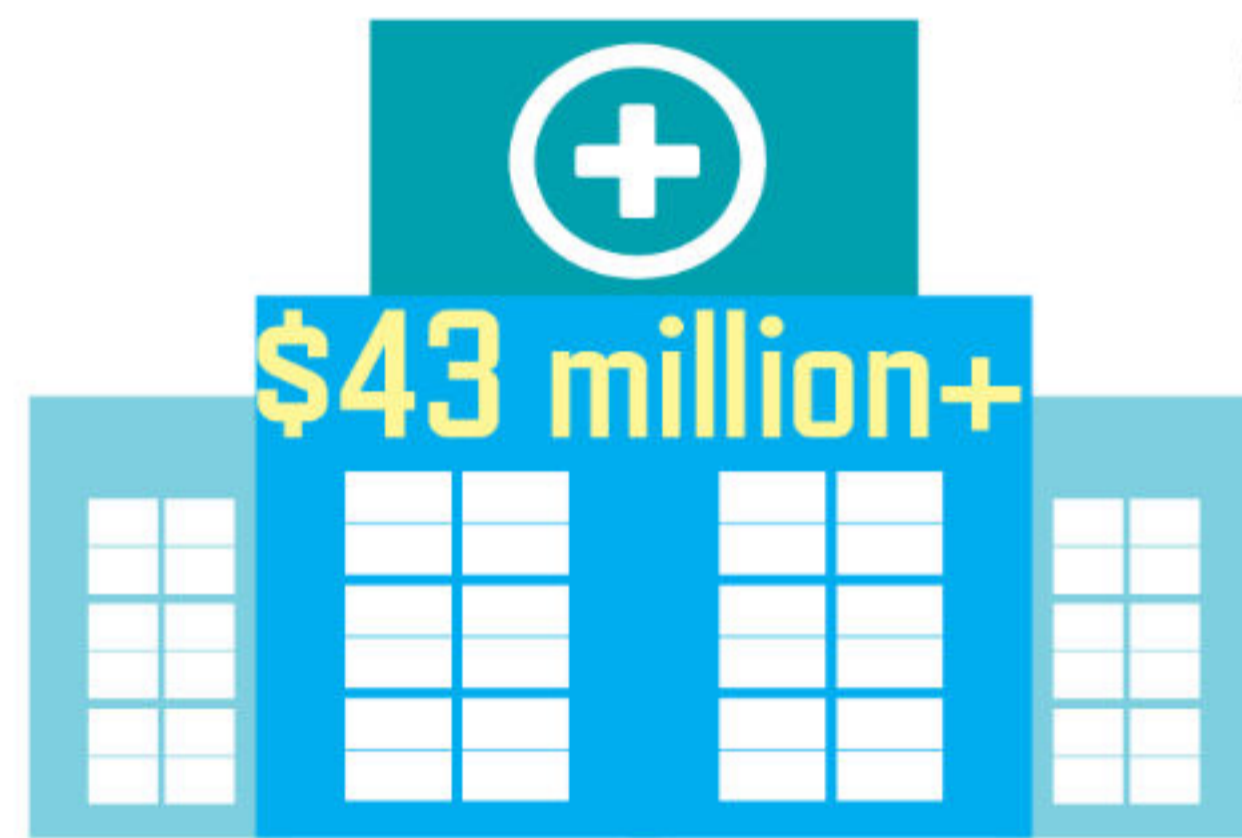

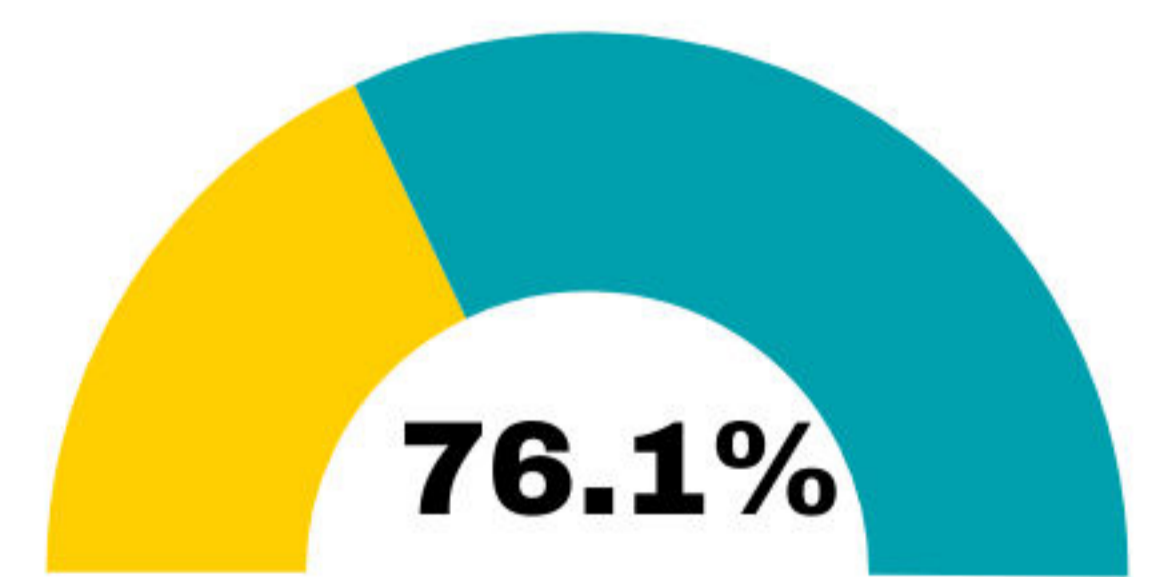

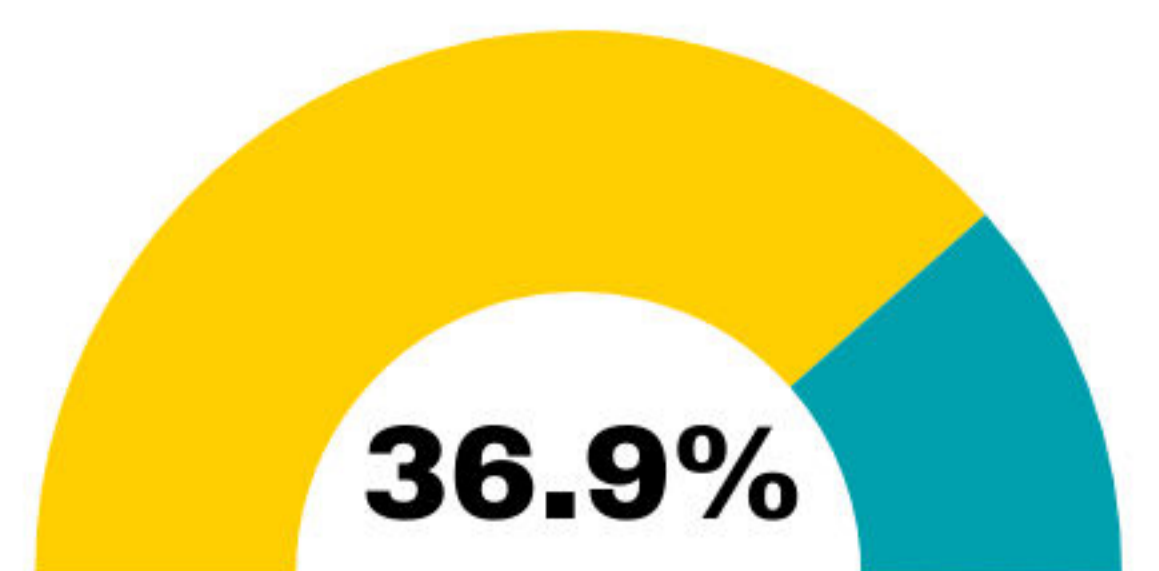
