

AIDS Pharmaceutical Assistance (APA) Formulary – July 2023

In accordance with Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) Policy Clarification Notice 16-02 (dated Oct 2018), a Local Pharmaceutical Assistance Program (LPAP) is operated by a Ryan White Part A or B recipient or subrecipient as a supplemental means of providing medication assistance when an AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) has a restricted formulary, waiting list and/or restricted financial eligibility criteria. Florida ADAP has a restricted formulary. Therefore, the Florida Ryan White Part B Program has elected to have one APA formulary statewide and to manage a statewide medication formulary workgroup to advise on the APA formulary. LPAP funds are not to be used for Emergency Financial Assistance (EFA); the EFA category, however, may assist with medications not covered by the LPAP.

Note: Combination products consisting of individual drugs that are listed on the APA are permitted, even if the combination product is not listed on the APA formulary. All dosage forms of drugs listed on the APA formulary can be purchased.
