



Faith Responds to AIDS

LEVELS OF INVOLVEMENT

Faith-based organizations (FBOs) that participate in the Faith Responds to AIDS (FRTA) initiative are asked to commit to making HIV prevention a priority. FRTA meets organizations and leaders where they are and provides opportunities to become involved by offering three levels of project engagement.

Level 1: Endorsement:

- FBO agrees with project goals and signs project commitment letter
- FBO agrees to display project logo and materials

Level 2: Support

- FBO agrees with project goals and signs project commitment letter
- FBO agrees to display project logo and materials
- FBO distributes project materials
- Faith leader agrees to talk to congregants and local community members about HIV
- FBO participates and/or supports health department-sponsored HIV events and activities

Level 3: Participation:

- FBO agrees with project goals and signs project commitment letter
- FBO agrees to display project logo and materials
- FBO distributes project materials
- FBO participates in free HIV/AIDS 101 training
- Faith leader agrees to talk to congregants and local community members about HIV
- FBO participates in and/or supports health department sponsored HIV events and activities
- FBO agrees to enhance or develop a health ministry that includes HIV outreach, education, and referrals

Once a level of engagement is selected, FBOs are asked to make a one-year commitment to keep the project logo and materials visible.
