The inability to control the patient's airway and ventilations is one of the great killers in the emergency setting. Avoiding the need for ET Tubes

- Positive Pressure Nebs
- Foreign body removal
- Non-desat procedures

- Prep - (O2 monitoring)
- Tube Management
- Bougie Stylette
- Laryngeal Manipulation

Difficult Intubation

- Neutral C-Spine
- Modified Positions
- Frontal Intubations
- Utilizing Stretcher/ Bed Positioning for Success

Drug Assisted Airways

- Sedation
- Analgesia
- Paralysis

Section 3

Last Resort Airways

- Needle Cricothyrotomy
- Surgical Cricothyrotomy

Advanced Devices

- Unique Blades
- Video Laryngoscopy

This skills-focused day will leave participants with many "tricks of the trade", feeling more confident with the airway anatomy, providing care and recognizing patients who may or may not be candidates for various procedures. Cases will be practiced in real time with the team making critical decisions relating to appropriate procedure, equipment and meds.
