Radon is in the air, inside and outside. The U.S. Congress has set a long-term goal that indoor radon levels be no more than outdoor levels.



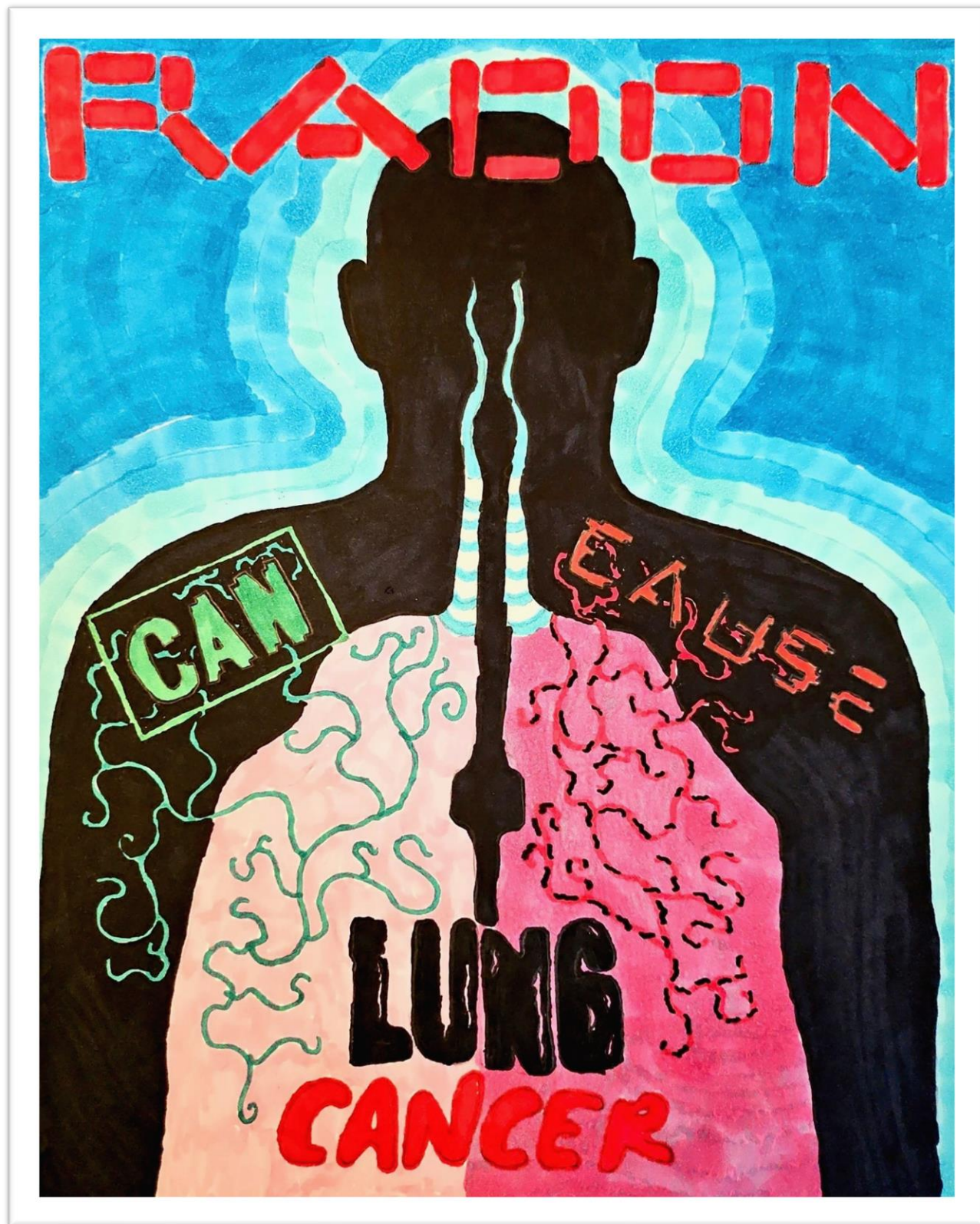
