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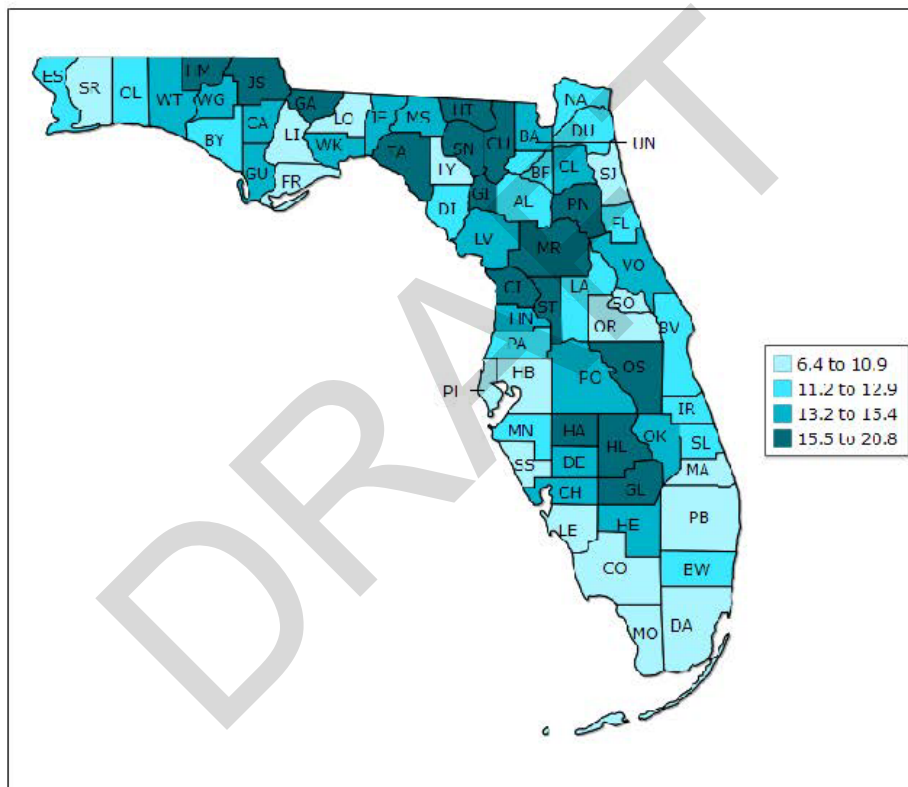


Diabetes. Age-adjusted Hospitalizations from or With Diabetes, Rate Per 100,000 Population, 2021

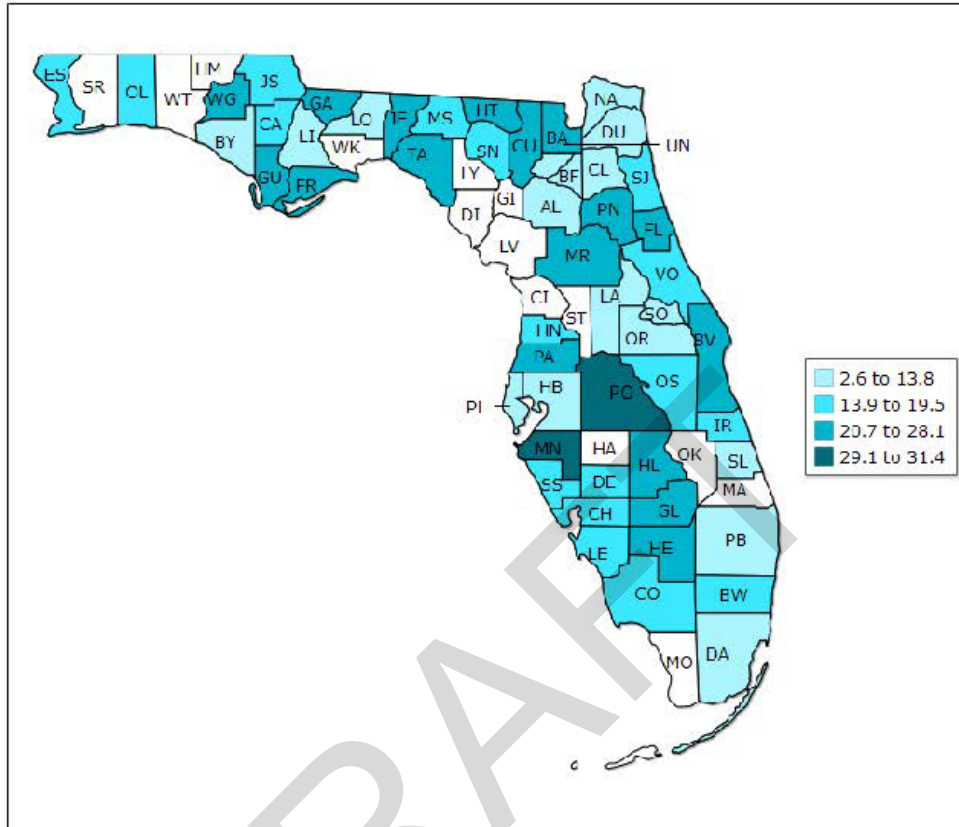

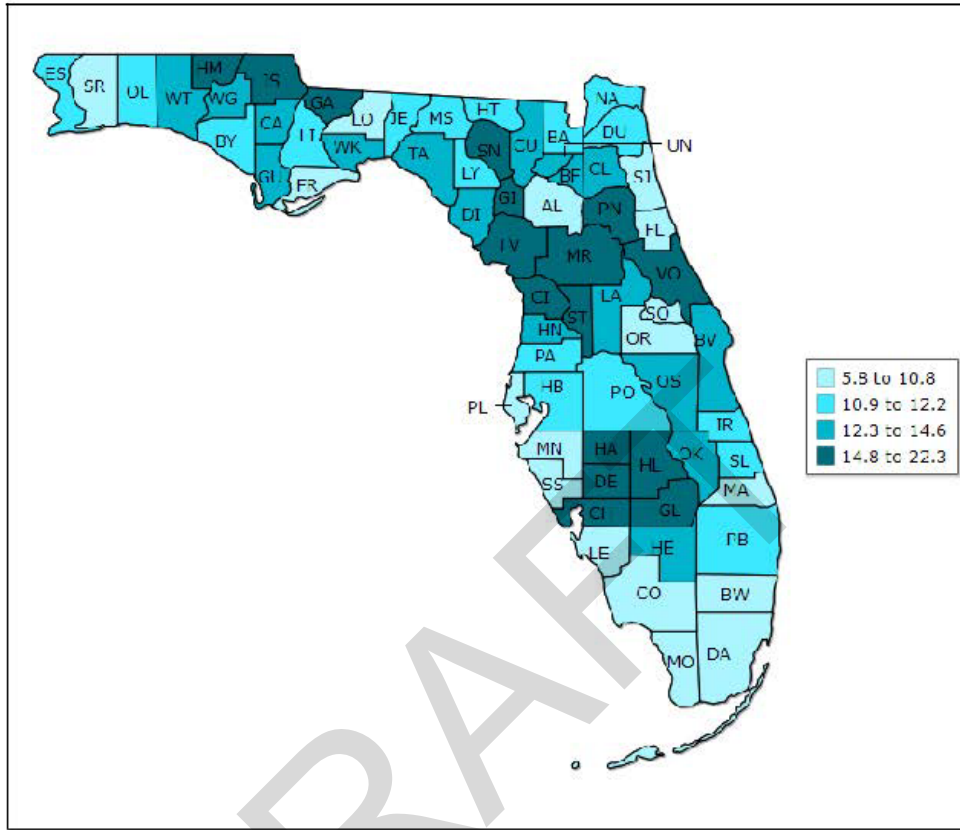

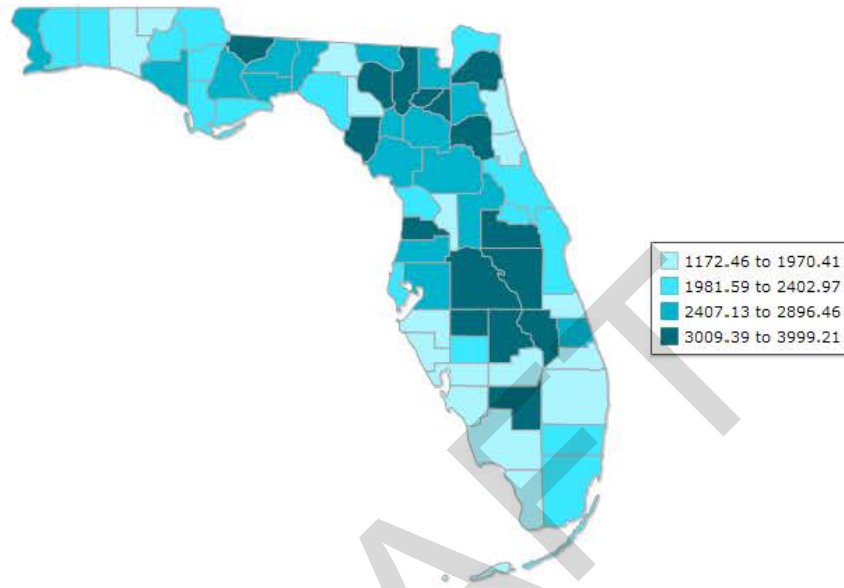

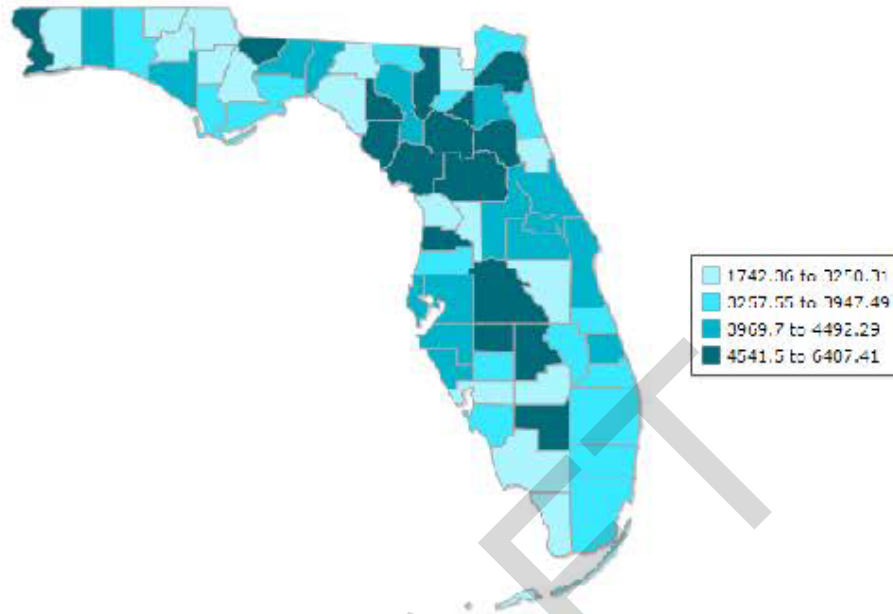

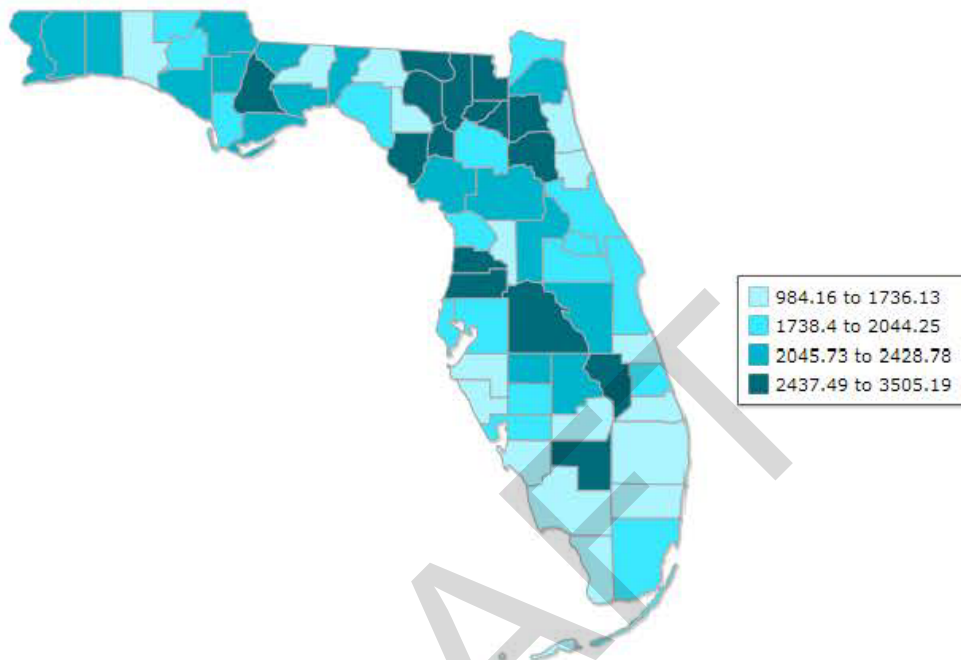

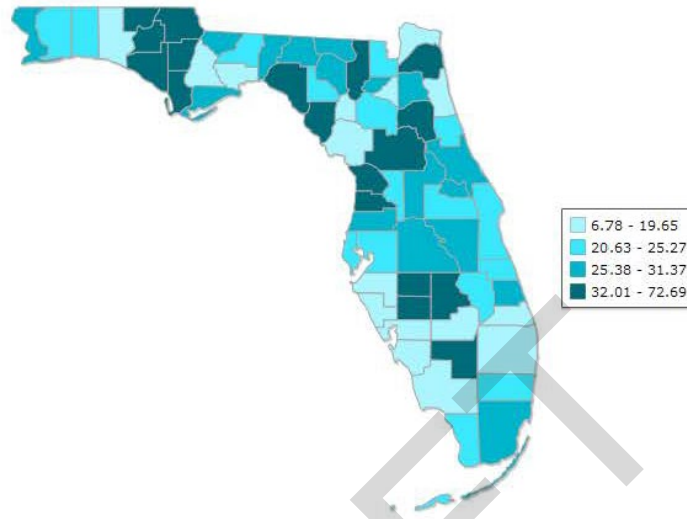

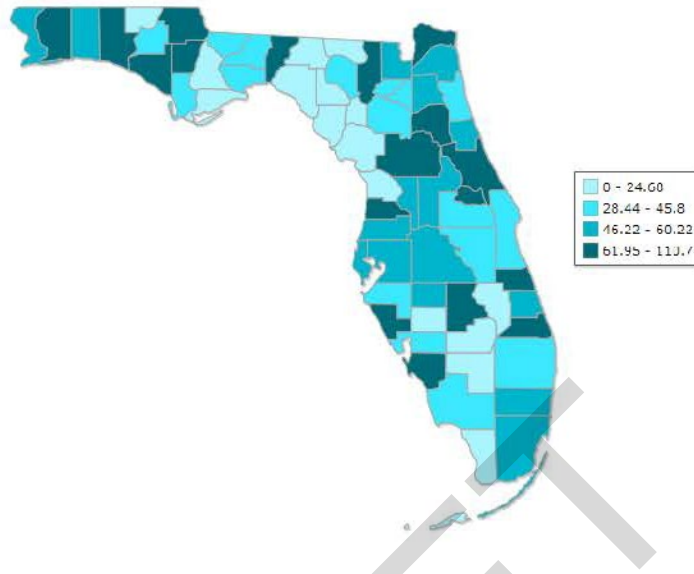

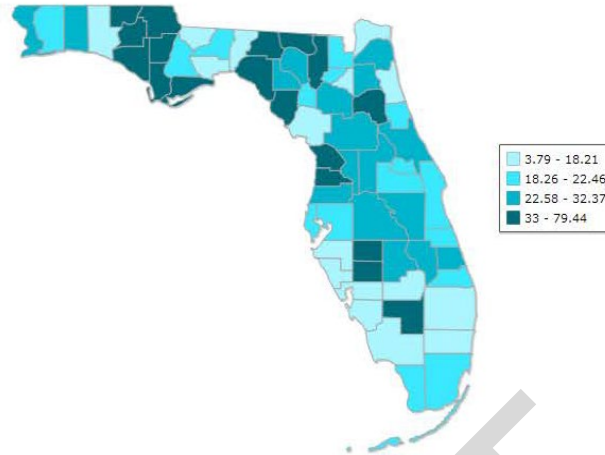
