These clients will have a reduction in milk of ½ gallon to 2 gallons per month.

Women will change from either 0 or 16 oz. per month to 48 oz. per month of whole grains. New sizes of whole grains (12 to 42 oz.) are allowed in all types of WIC-eligible whole grain foods such as whole grain bread products, whole wheat and corn tortillas, whole wheat pasta, brown rice, oats, and bulgur. <b>Yogurt</b>  Note: Unit of measure will be changed to “ounces” instead of “tubs.”	32 oz. tub whole, lowfat, reduced fat or fat free yogurt--Original or Greek  16, 24, 32, 48 and 72 oz. multipacks of single-serving reduced fat, lowfat, or fat free yogurt--Original only	Women and children will be able to receive 32 or 64 oz. yogurt per month. Prior to October 1, 2025, clients were able to receive a maximum of 32 oz. yogurt per month.  24, 48, and 72 oz. sizes of multipacks of single-serving Original reduced fat, lowfat, or fat free yogurt will be added.  <b>To be implemented by April 20, 2026:</b> Any yogurt that contains more than the following amount of added sugar will be removed from the approved product list: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 12 grams per 6 oz. (170 grams)</li> <li>• 8 grams per 4 oz. (113 grams)</li> </ul> <b>To be implemented by April 19, 2027:</b> Any yogurt that contains less than the following amount of vitamin D will be removed from the approved product list: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 79.5 IU (2 micrograms) per 6 oz. <b>Juice</b>	64 and 128 fl. oz. bottles or jugs of refrigerated Orange Juice  64 and 128 fl. oz. bottles or jugs of shelf-stable juices	Prior to October 1, 2025, most women and children received 96 to 144 fl. oz. juice per month. Beginning October 1, 2025, the maximum amount of juice per month will be 64 fl. oz. for all women and children.  These juices will be added: 64 fl. oz. Low Sodium Vegetable Juice 64 fl. oz. Low Sodium Tomato Juice	48 and 96 fl. oz. bottles/packages of juice and frozen concentrate juice will be phased out.
<b>Fruits and Vegetables (cash value benefits)</b>	Any size fresh, frozen, and canned fruits and vegetables	Clients will be given an additional \$3.00 per month to purchase fruits and vegetables unless they choose to receive 64 fl. oz. juice per month.  Fresh herbs cut at the root or with the root intact will be allowed.	
<b>Baby Foods</b>	4 oz. jar or tub  4 oz. package of 2-pack of 2 oz. container  8 oz. package of 2-pack of 4 oz. container	There are no changes in allowed sizes and types of baby foods but amount per month will be reduced. Beginning October 1, 2025, for infants, baby cereal will be reduced from 24 oz. to either 8 or 16 oz. per month. Also, some infants will receive a reduced amount of baby fruits and vegetables and baby meat each month.	
<b>Infant Formula</b>	The allowed sizes and brands are specified on the client's shopping list.	No changes in formula brands or amount per month, except some infants will receive an increased amount of formula when they are less than one month of age.
