The Florida Prenatal Screen INFORMATION FOR OUR COMMUNITY PARTNERS



Help keep Florida moms and babies healthy through pregnancy and delivery with the new digital Florida Prenatal Screen. You play a critical role by encouraging health care providers to register their facility for the digital screen.

In July 2024, the Florida Prenatal Screen will be launched in a new, modern digital format. Help spread the message about this new digital format with providers in your area. The digital format means moms will receive critical support services more quickly.

Providers need to know:

- Beginning in July 2024, the Florida Prenatal Screen will be available in a new, modern digital format. To access the new digital version of the screen, a facility can register at:

- According to section 383.14, Florida Statutes, all Florida health care providers delivering prenatal services are required to provide the Prenatal Screen at every pregnant woman's initial prenatal visit.

How a Community Partner can help:

- Communicate with all of your local facilities to inform them about the new digital format and encourage them to register their facility.
- Deliver educational materials to providers in your service area. Give each provider the educational folder filled with instructional materials within the first month of receipt.
