

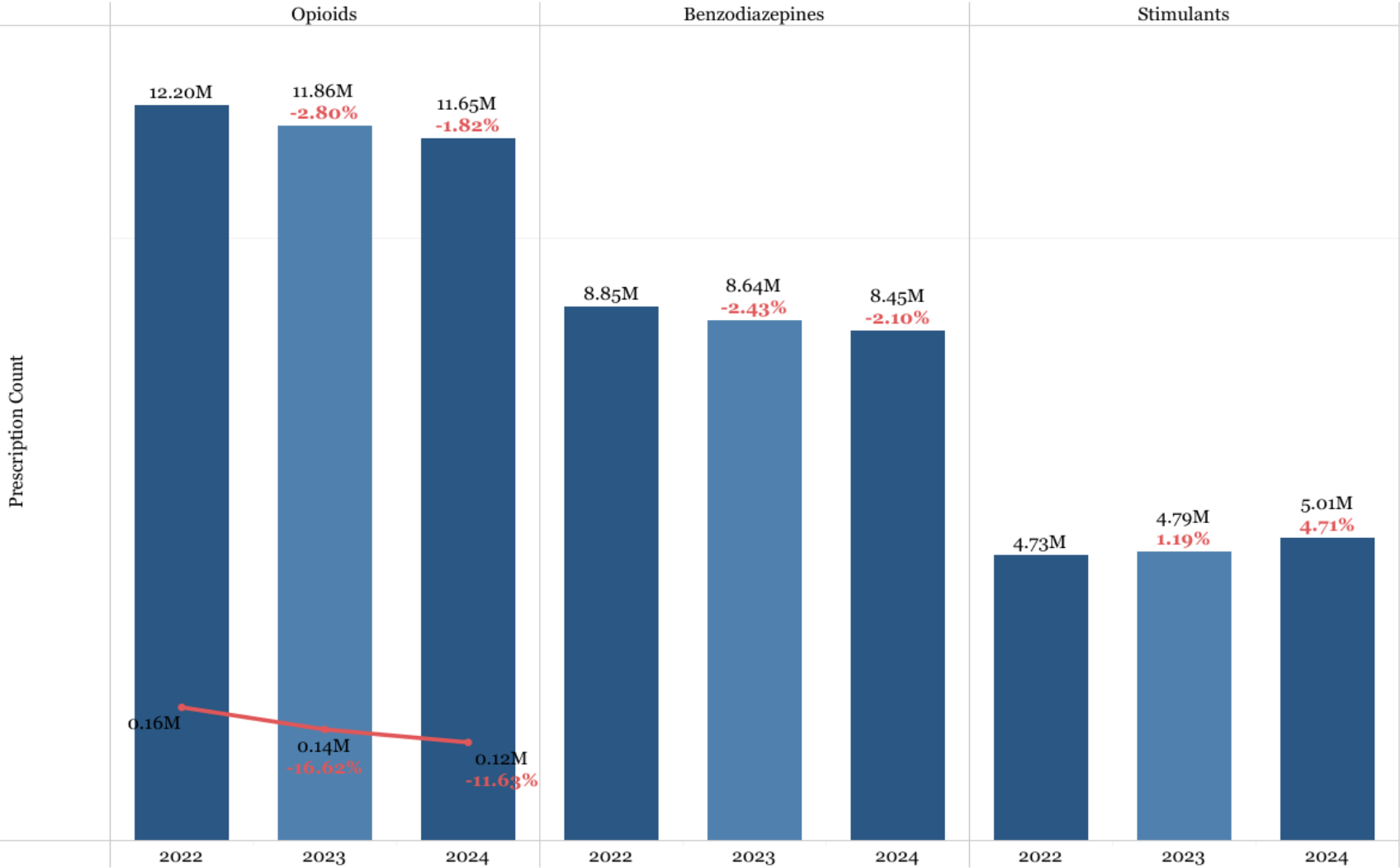
Florida Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) Monthly Report

Prescriptions by Drug Type & Year

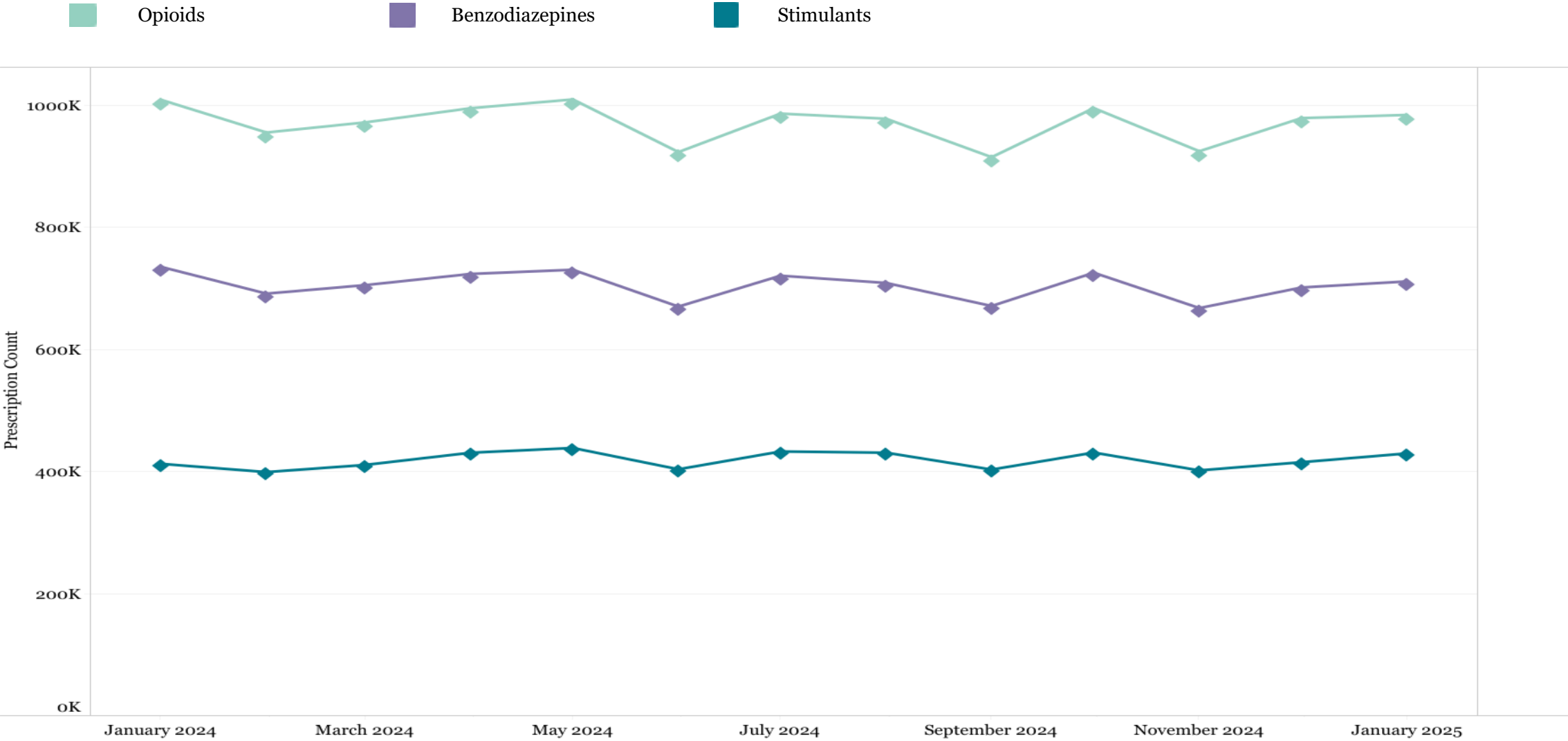

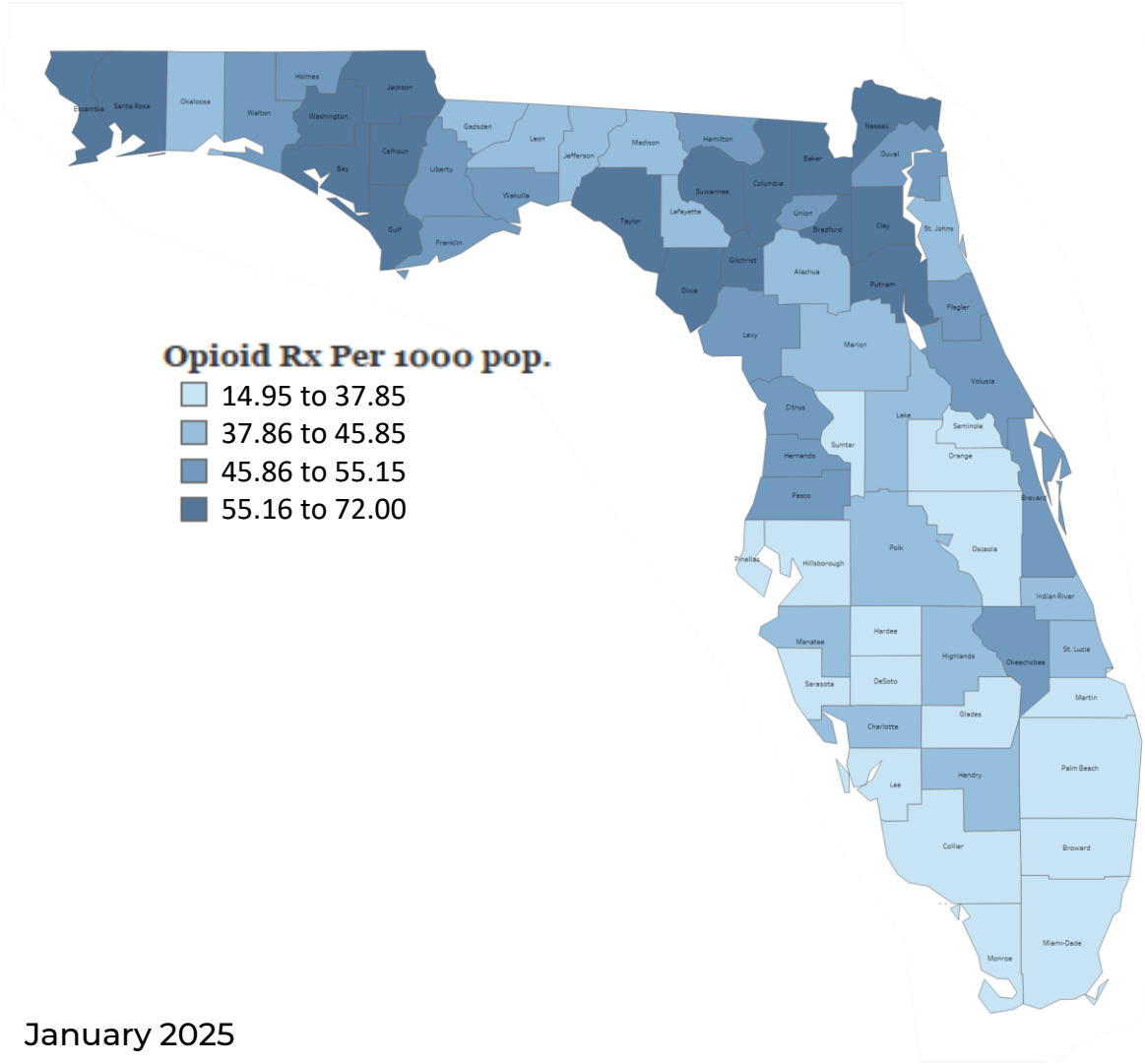

Opioid Prescription Rate & Percent Change by County

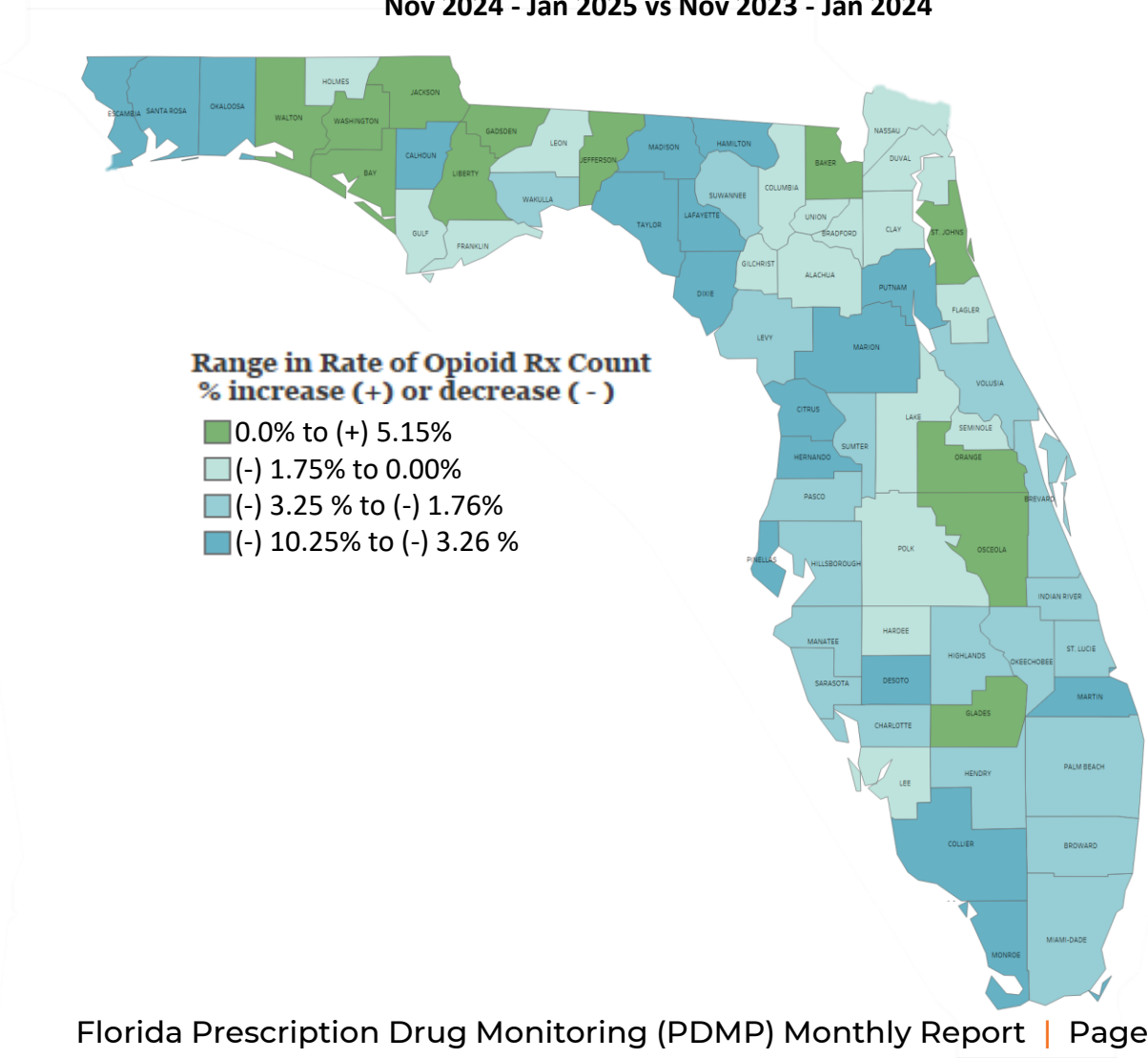

January 2025



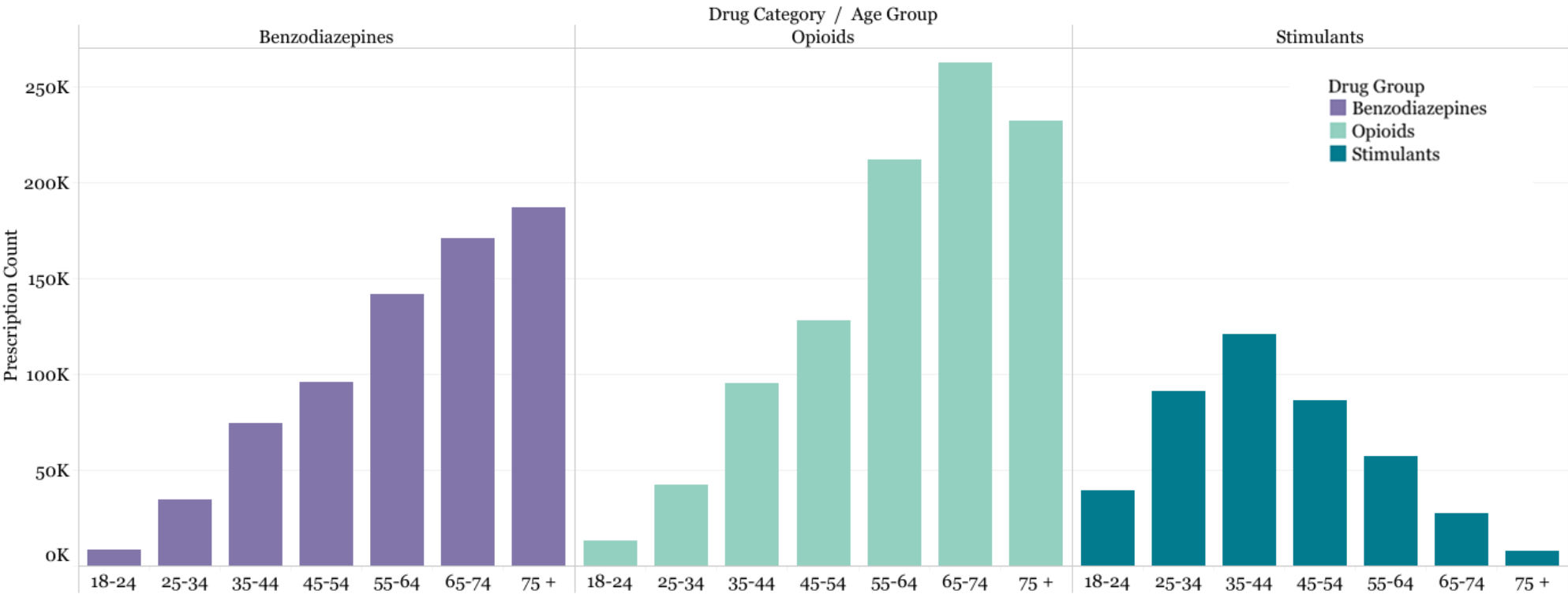
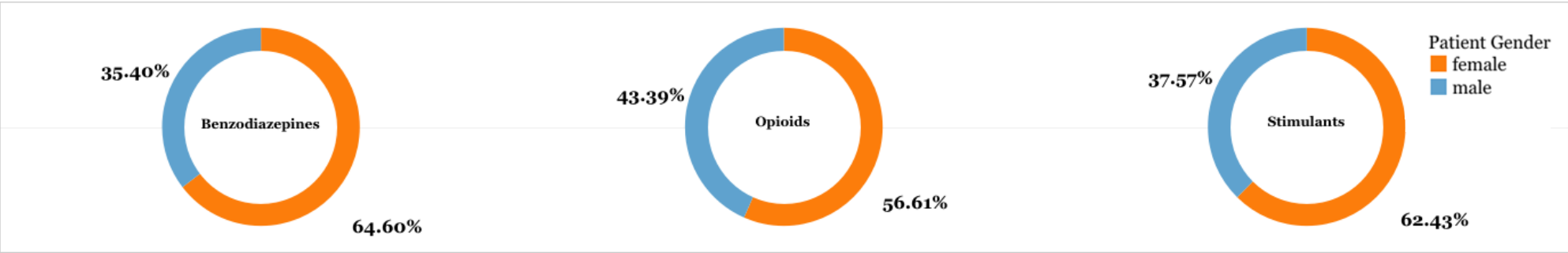

Opioid, Benzodiazepine & Stimulant Prescriptions by Sex and Age

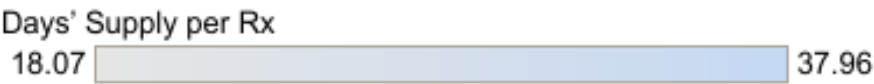
