

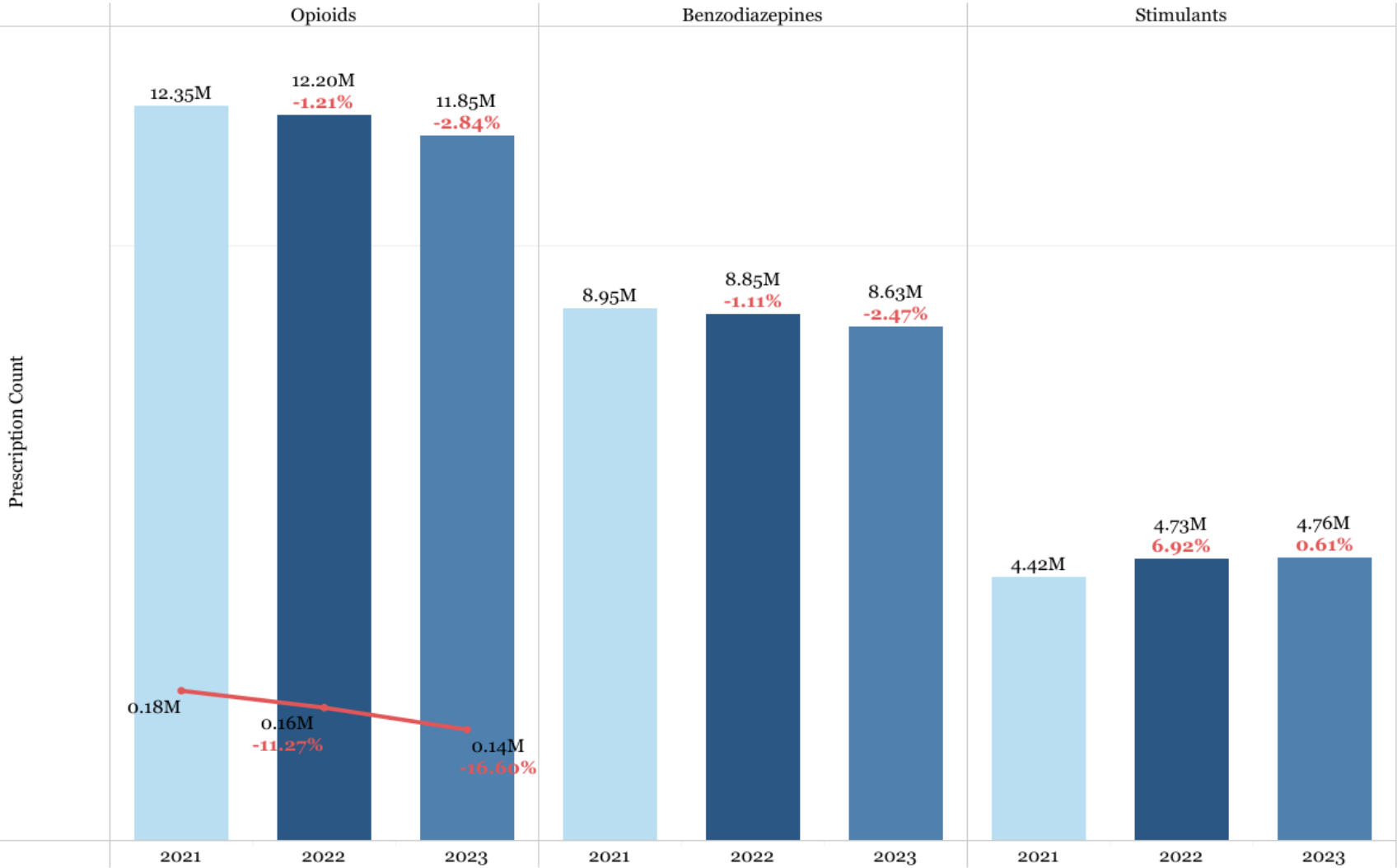
Florida Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) Monthly Report

Prescriptions by Drug Type & Year

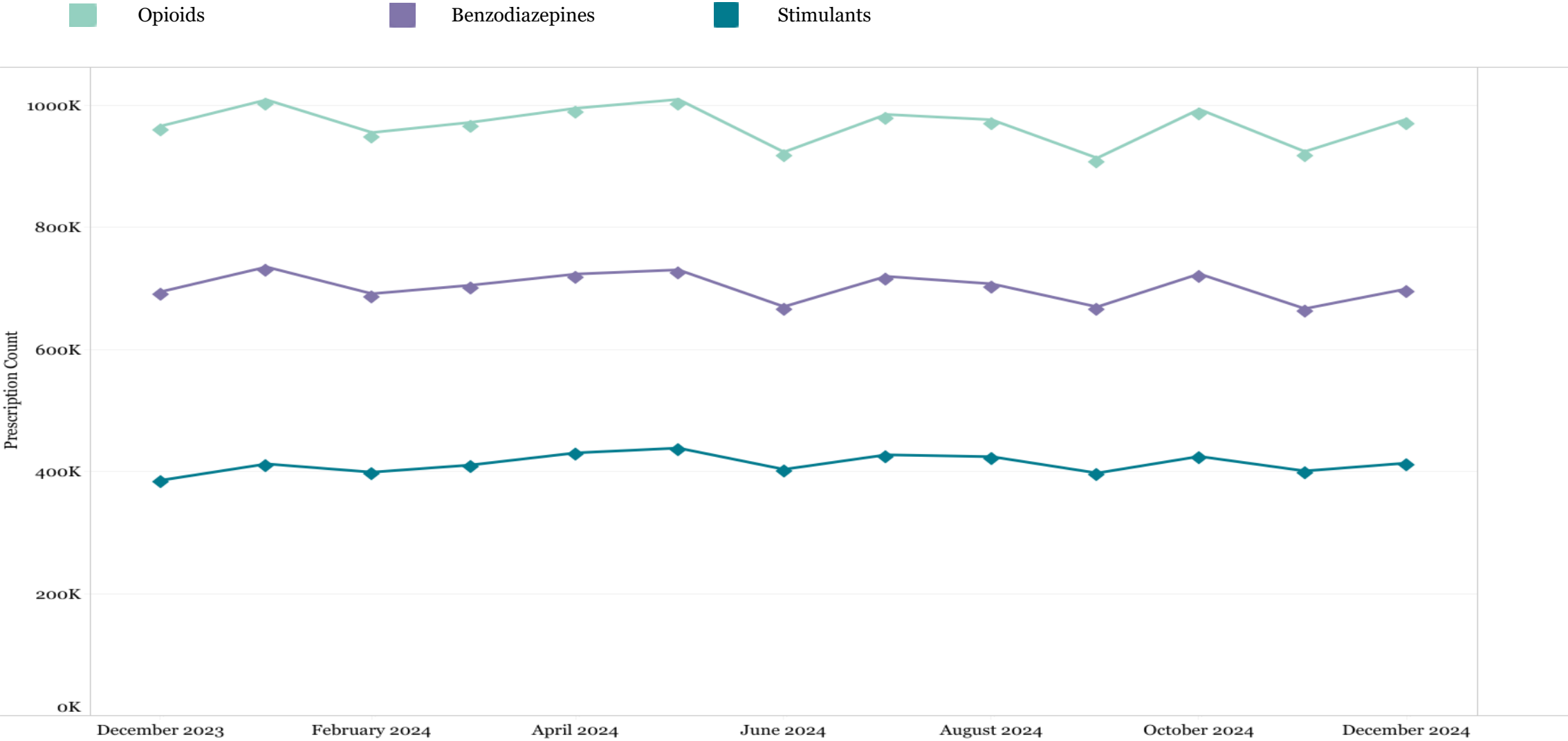
Florida, 2021-2023

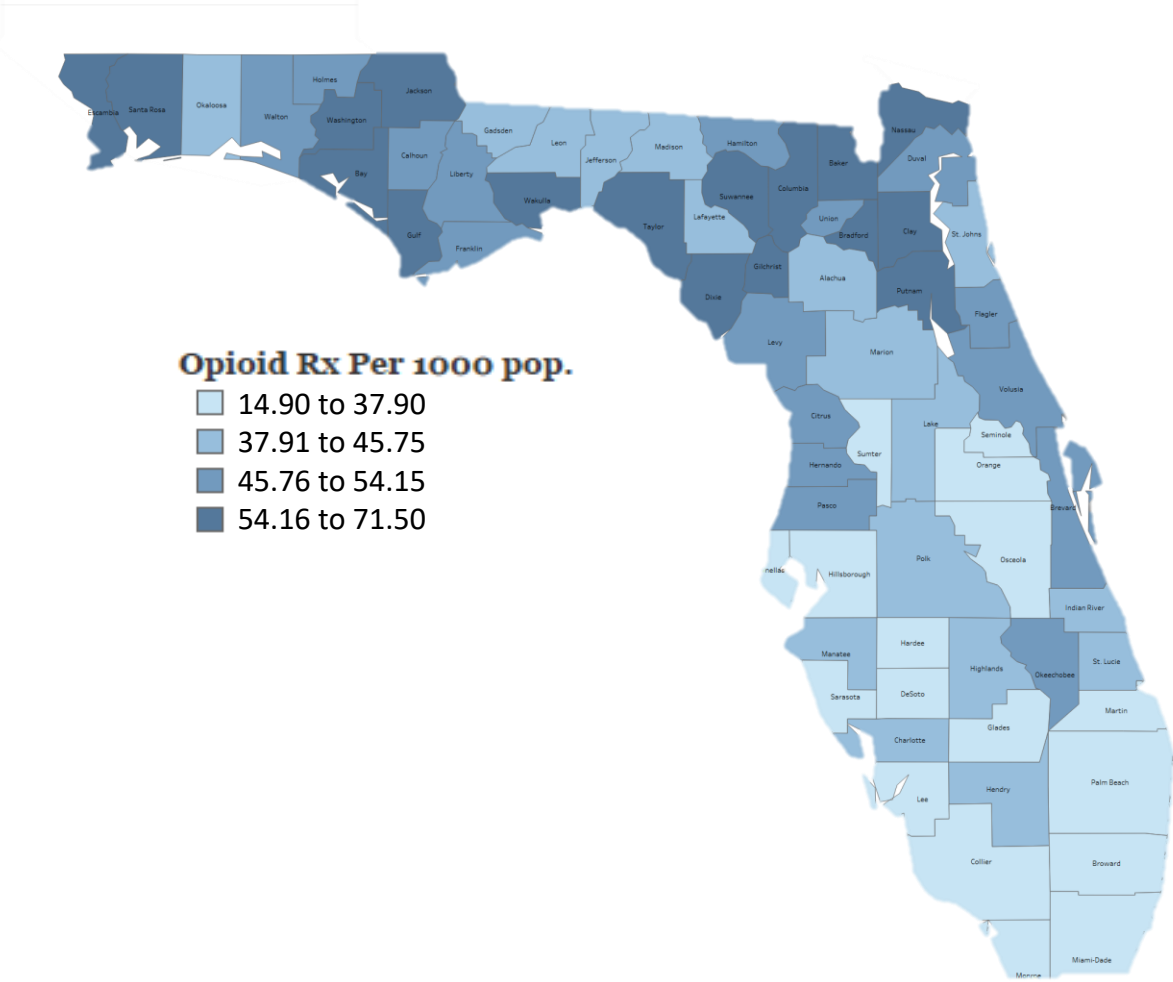

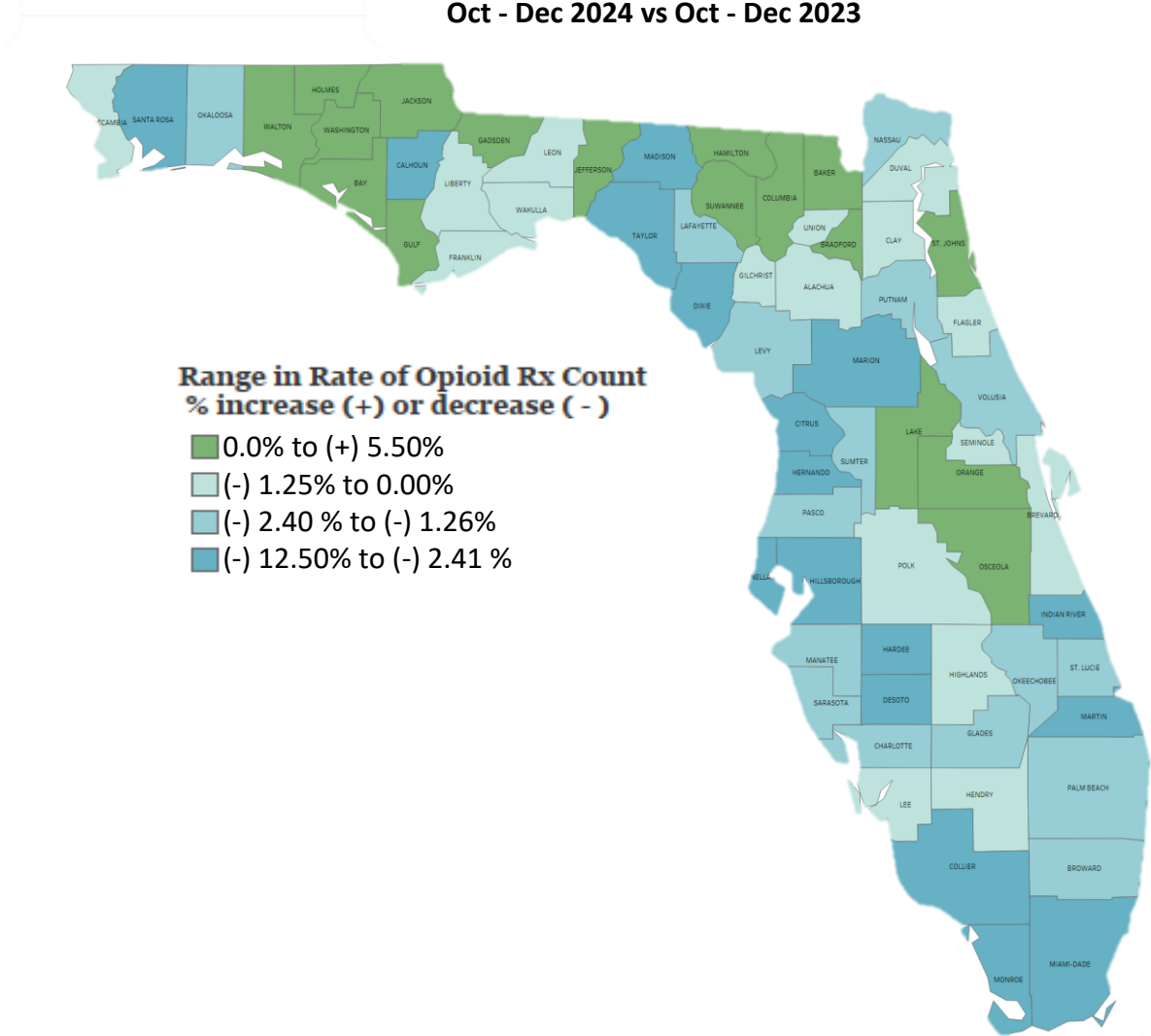

December, 2024



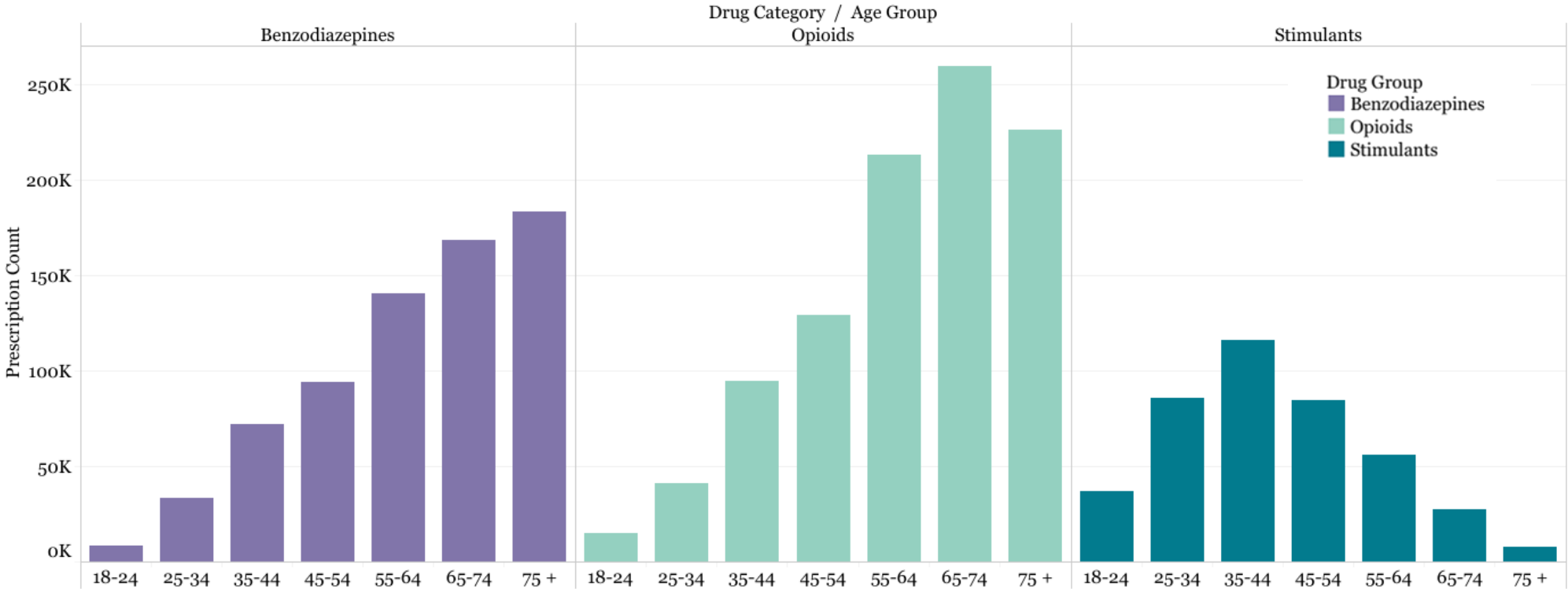
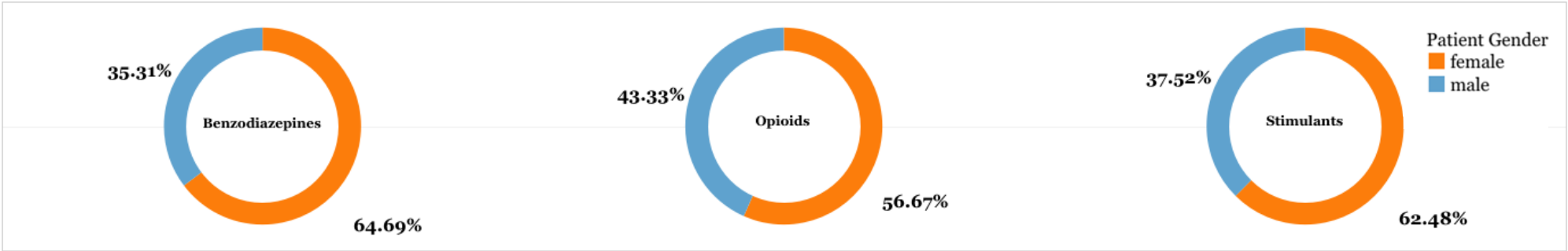
