

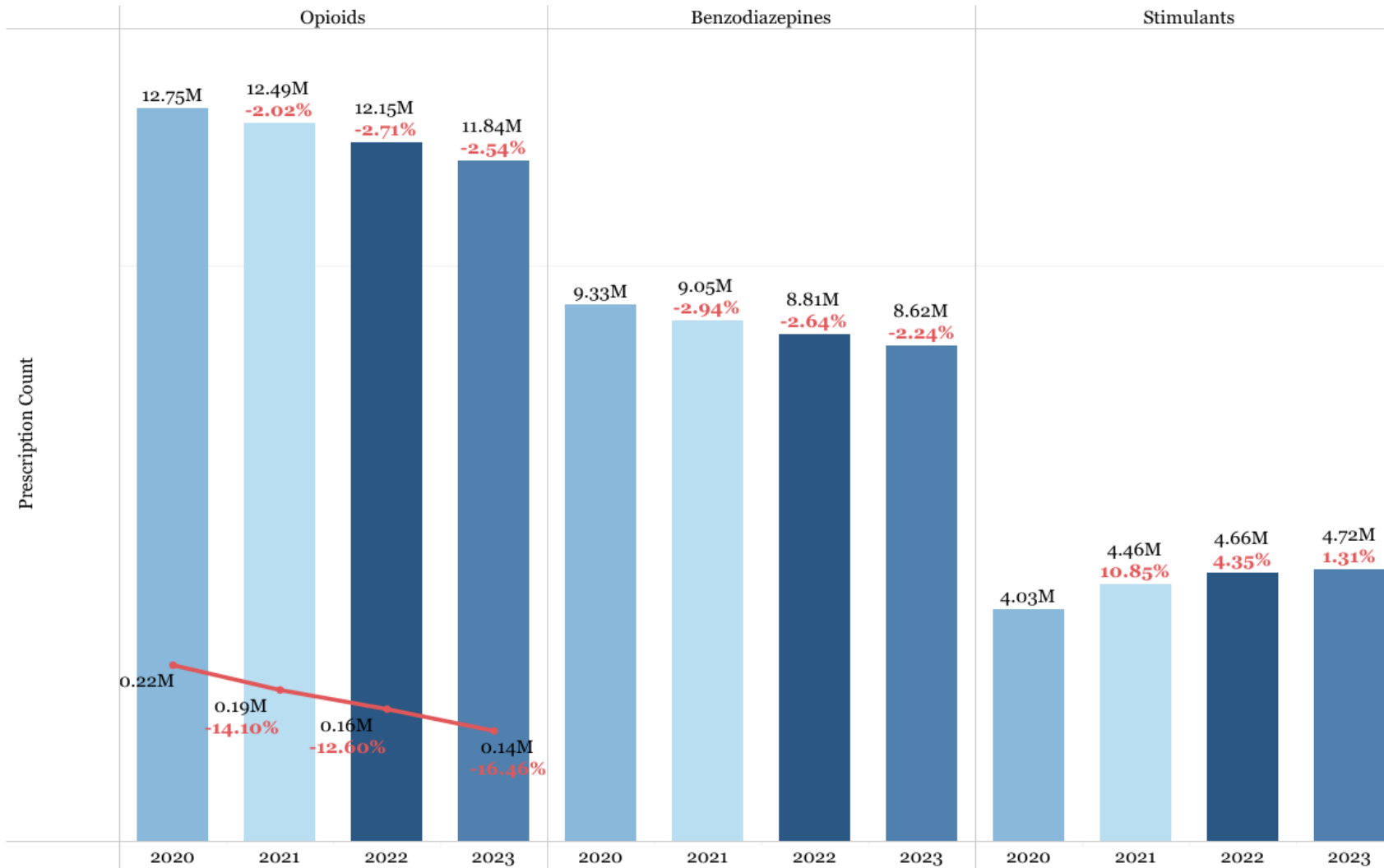
# Florida Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) Monthly Report

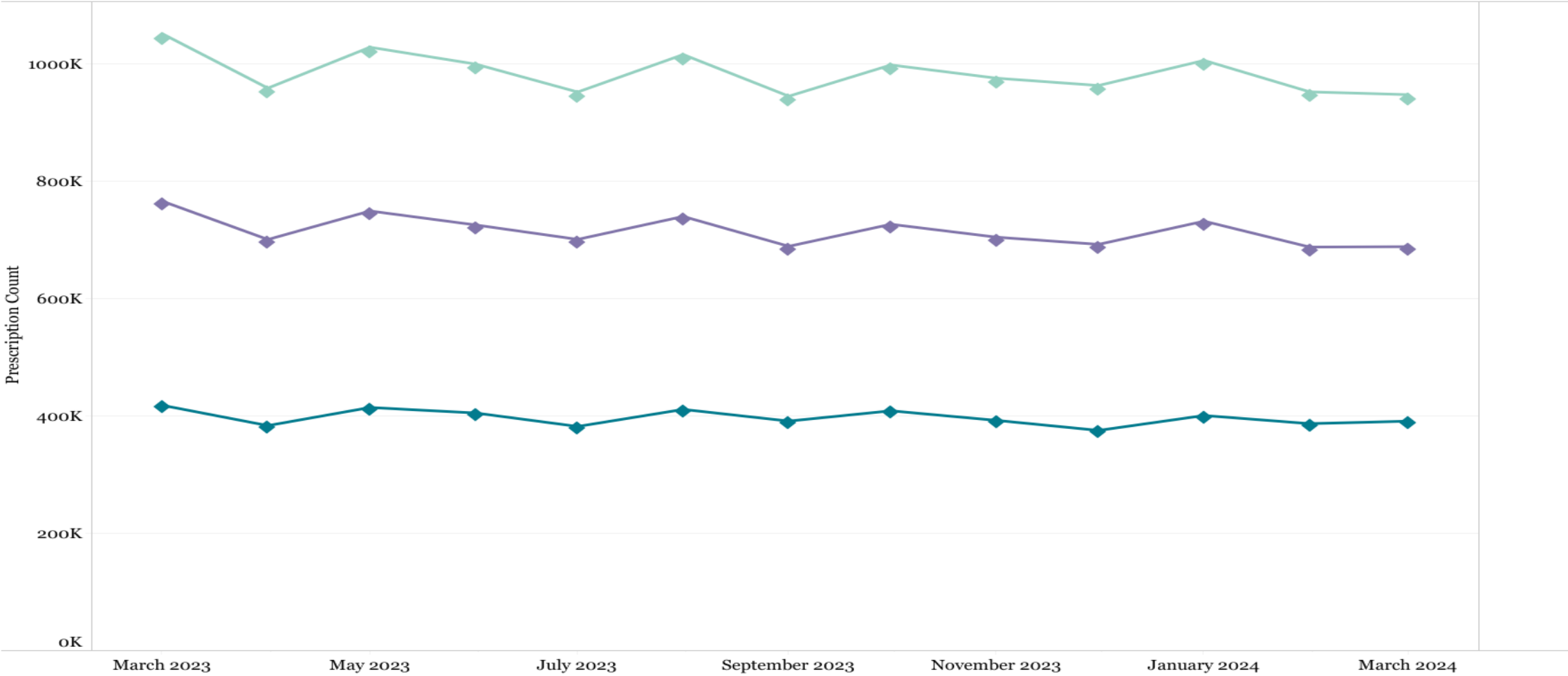


- The red line represents the number of fentanyl prescriptions.

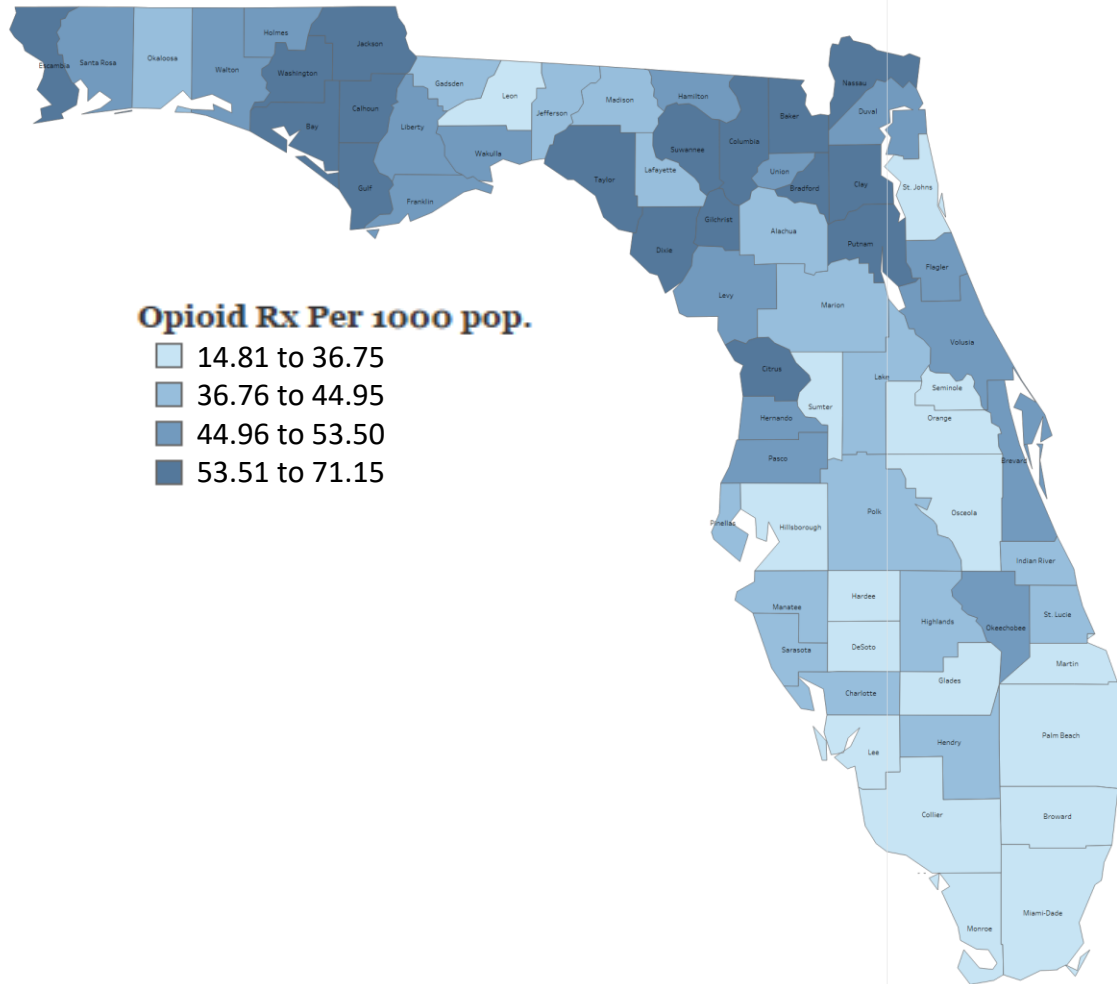

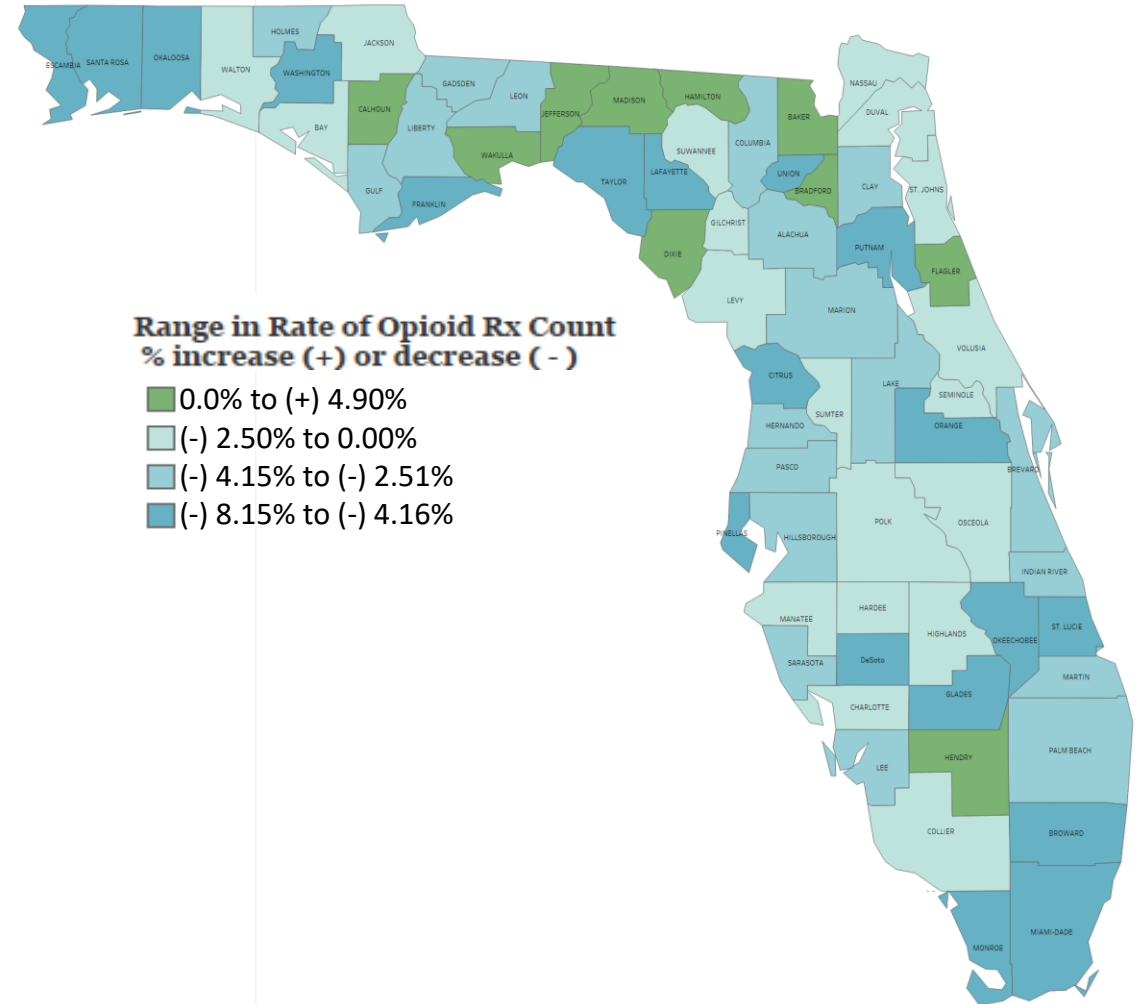
# Opioid Prescription Rate & Percent Change by County

### Age-Adjusted Opioid Prescription Rate by County, Florida March, 2024

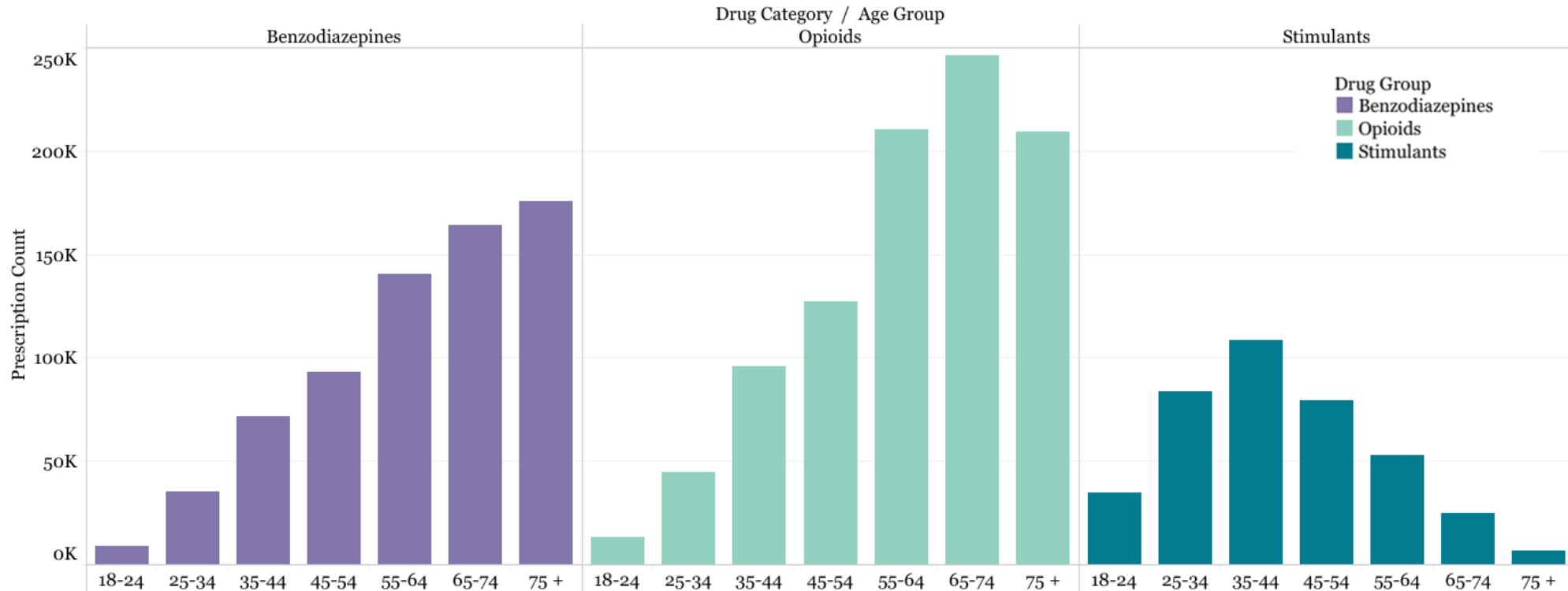
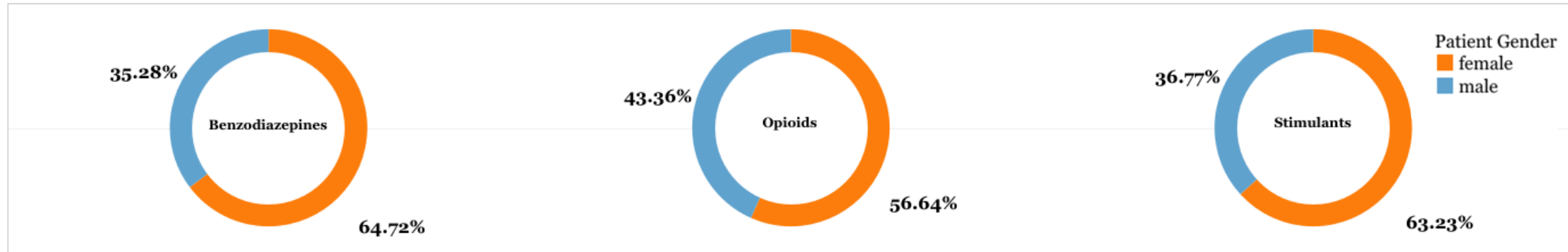


### Percent Change in Opioid Prescription Count by County, Florida Jan - Mar 2024 vs Jan - Mar 2023

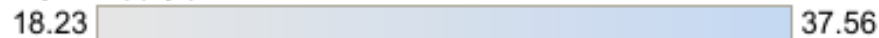

alprazolam, amitriptyline HCl/chlordiazepoxide, chlordiazepoxide HCl, chlordiazepoxide/clidinium bromide, clobazam, clonazepam, clorazepate dipotassium, diazepam, estazolam, flurazepam HCl, lorazepam, **midazolam, midazolam HCl, midazolam HCl in 0.9 % sodium chloride/PF, midazolam HCl/PF, midazolam/ketamine HCl/ondansetron HCl**, oxazepam, quazepam, temazepam, triazolam

## Stimulants Include:
