

# Florida Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) Monthly Report

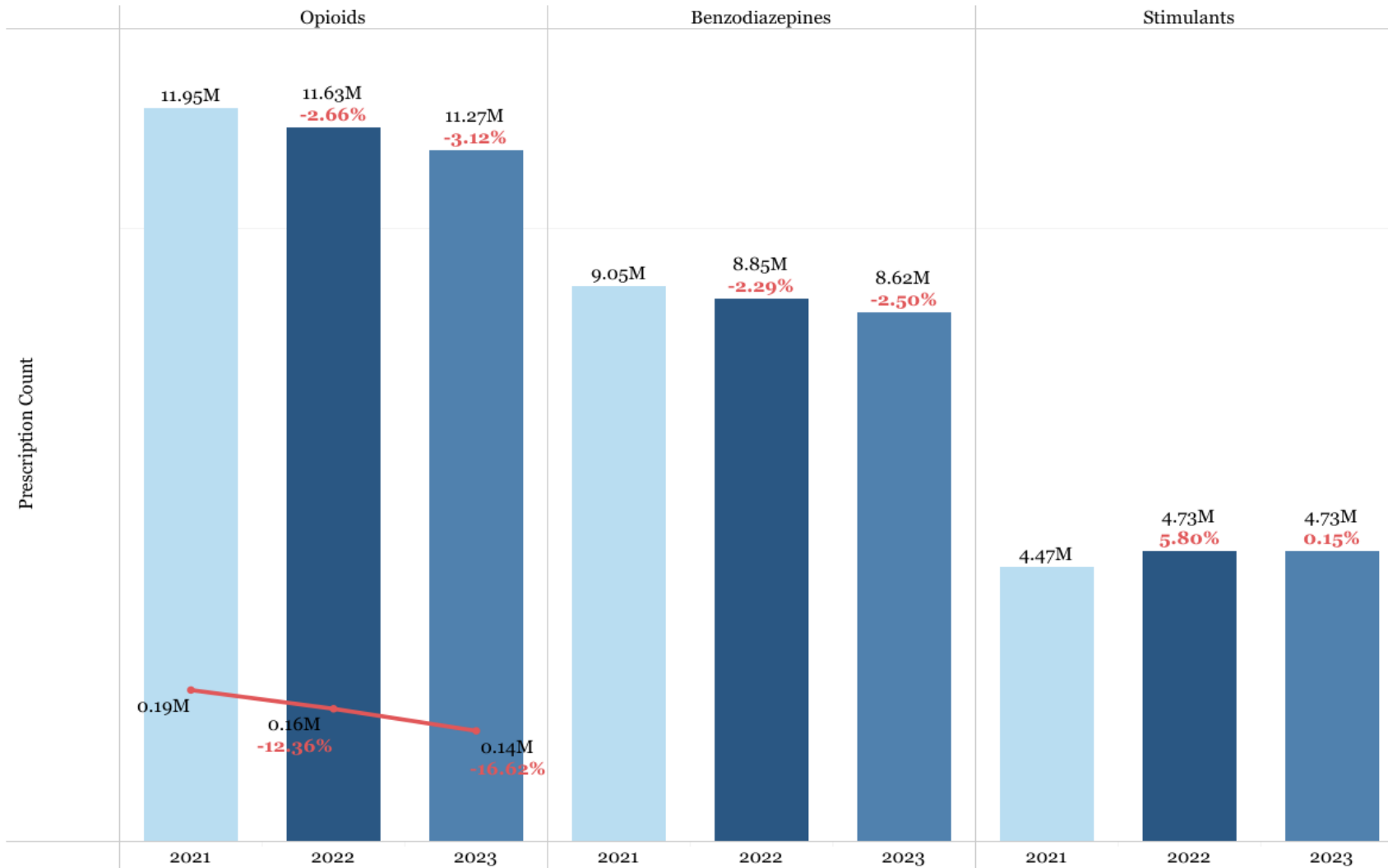

# Prescriptions by Drug Type & Year

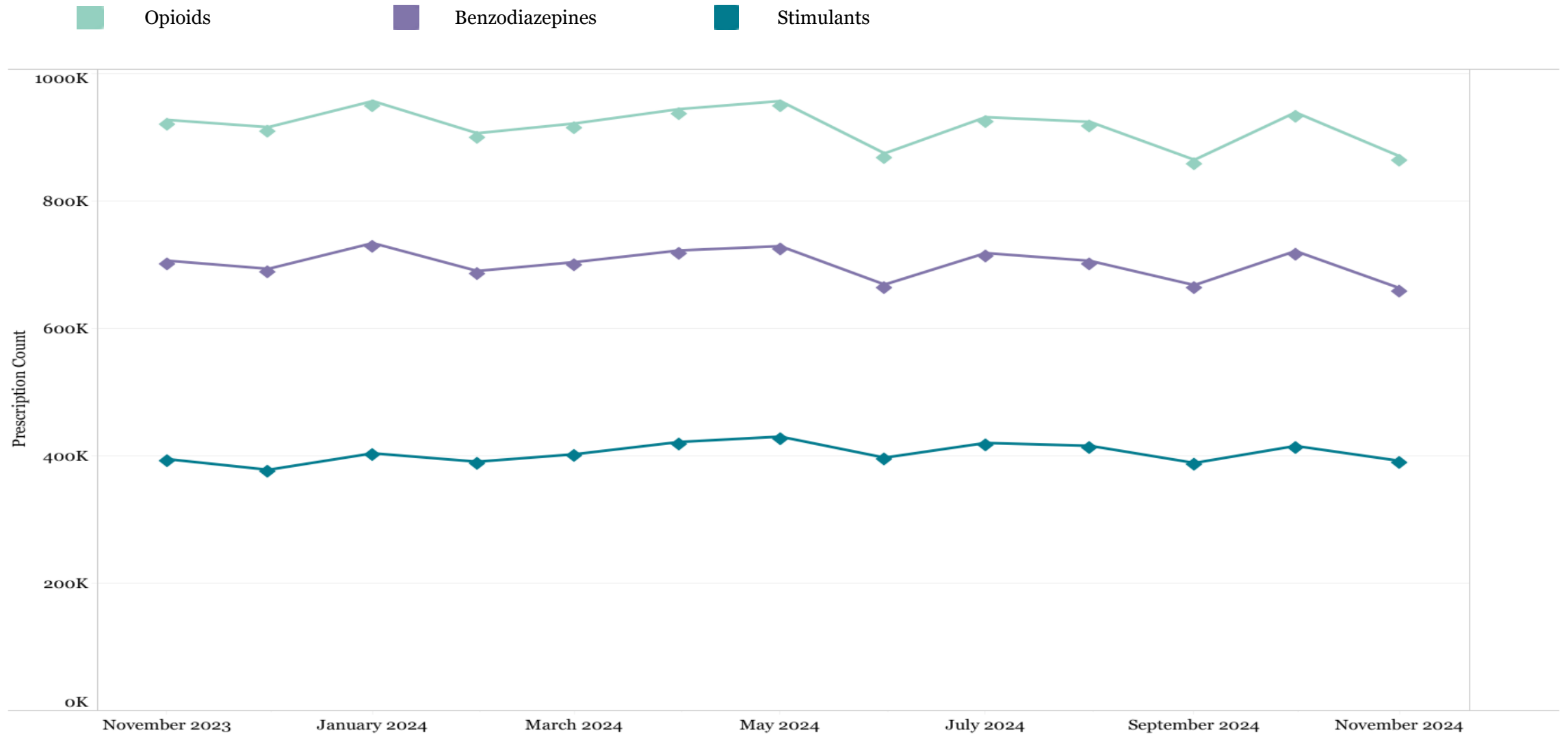
Florida, 2021-2023

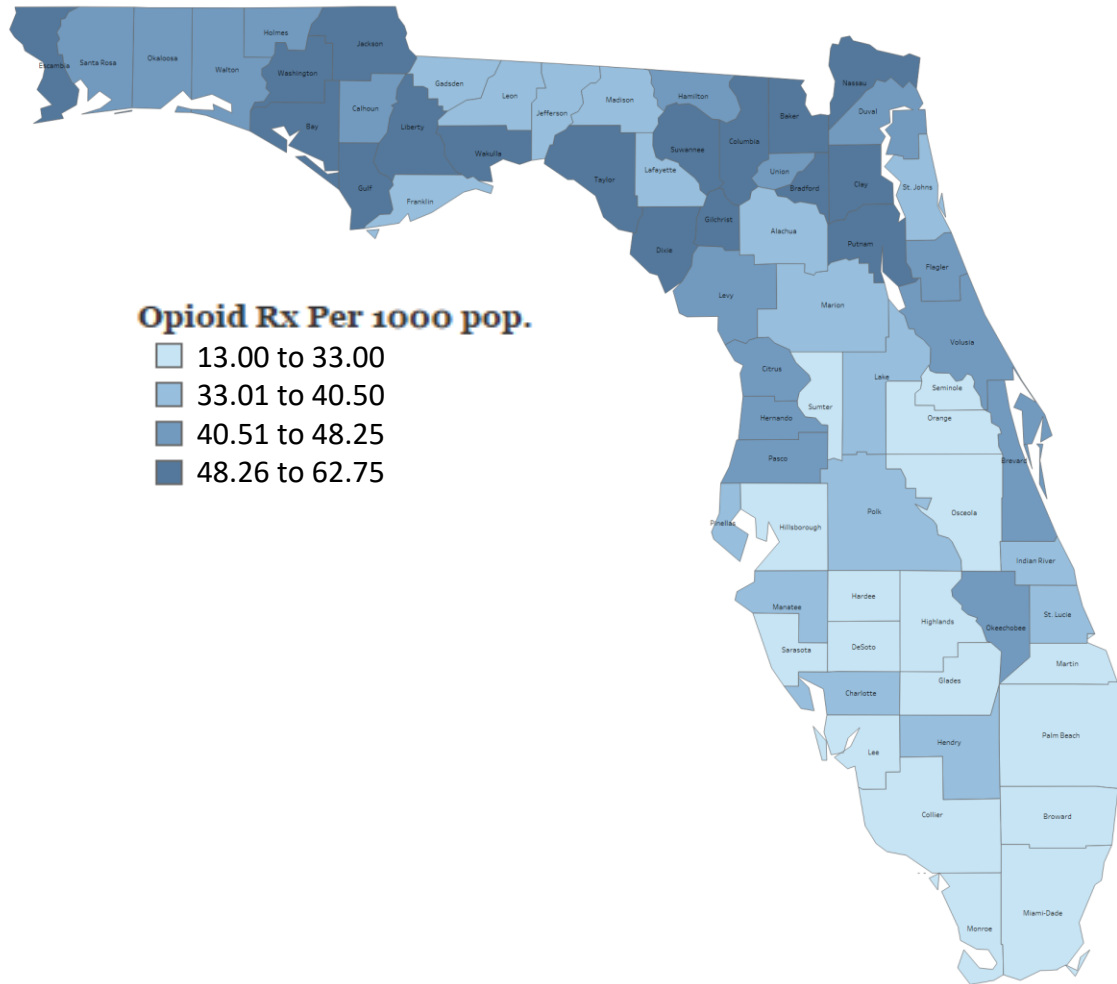

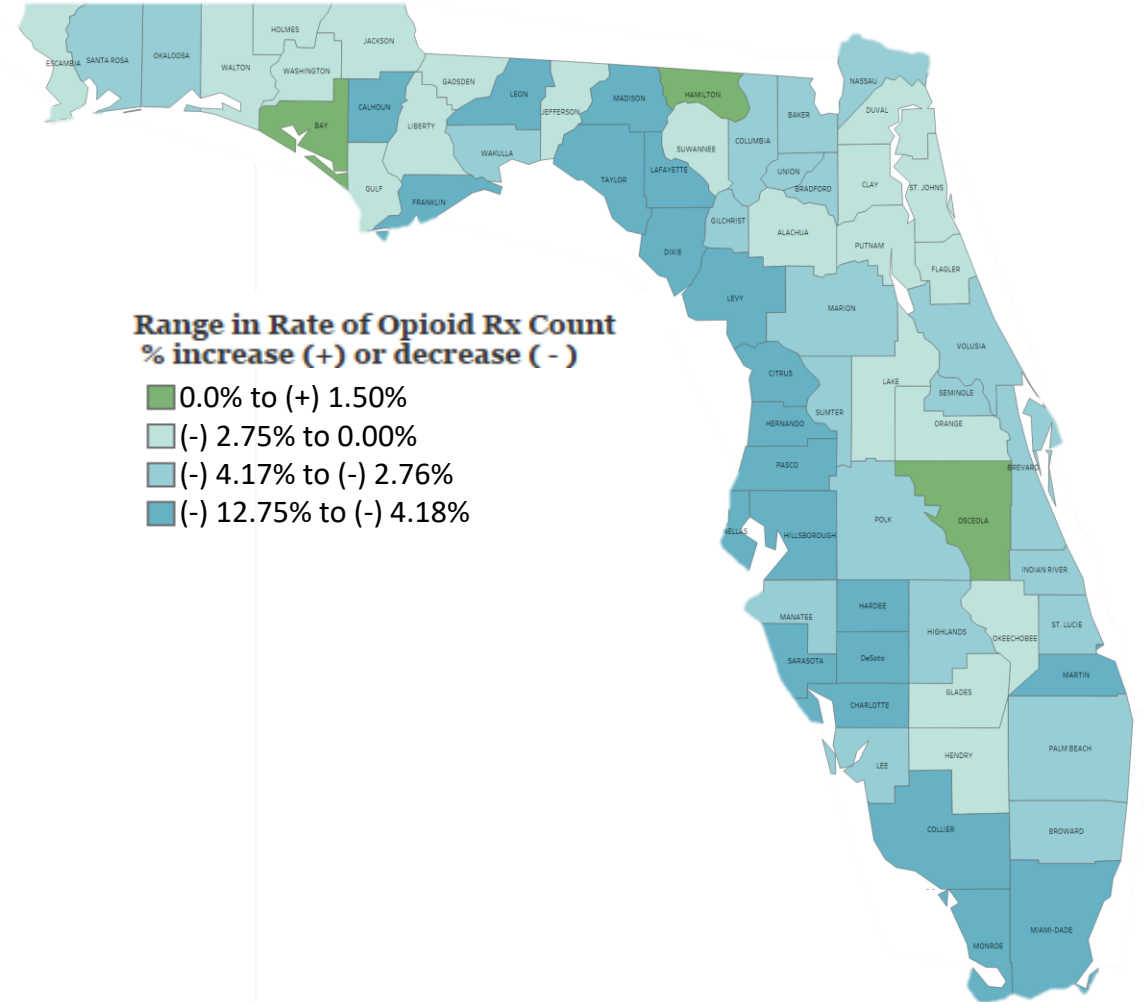
# Opioid Prescription Rate & Percent Change by County

### Age-Adjusted Opioid Prescription Rate by County, Florida November, 2024

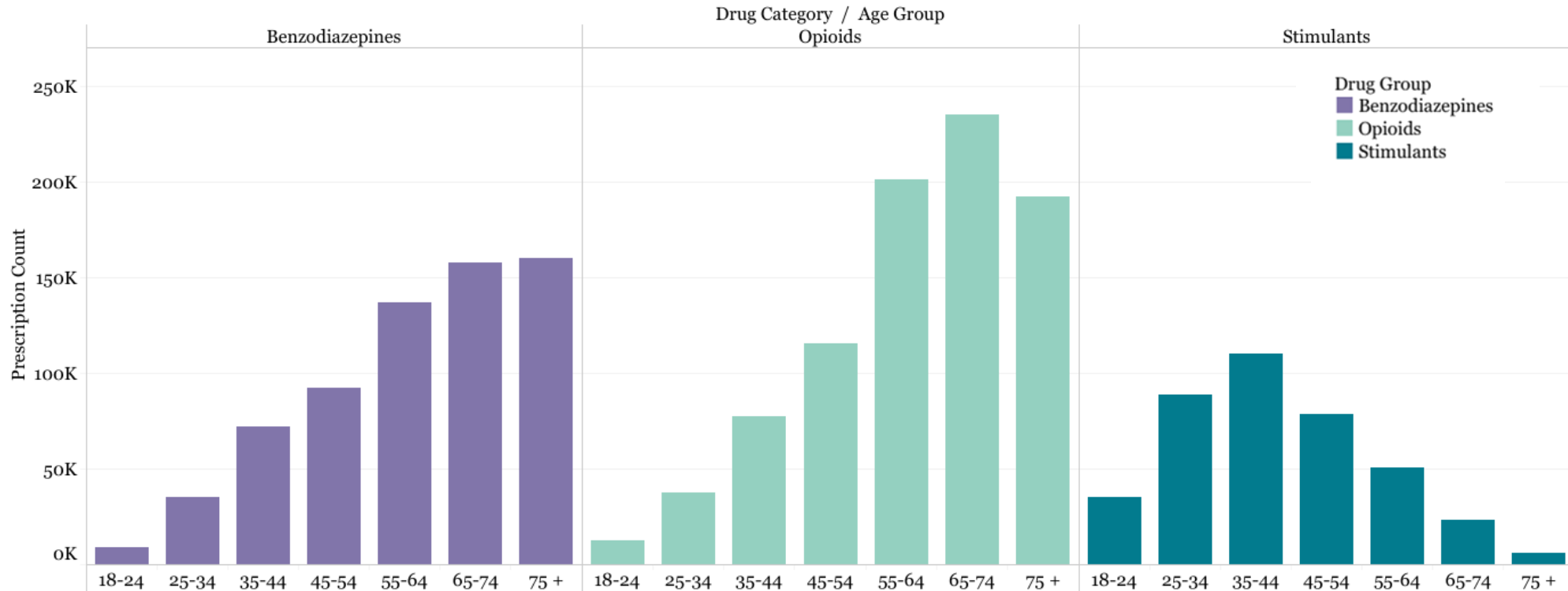
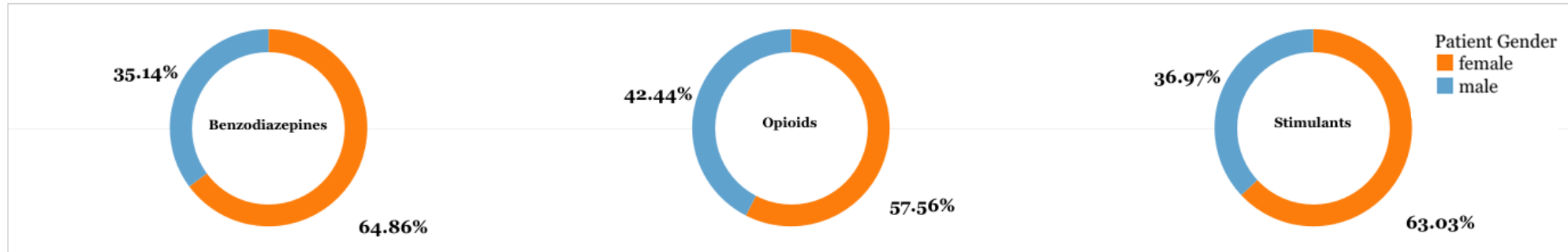


### Percent Change in Opioid Prescription Count by County, Florida Sep - Nov 2024 vs Sep - Nov 2023

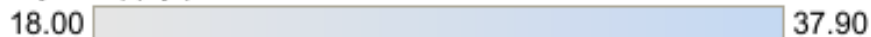
